WOZNIACKI travelled on the outside of horses in mid-division, inched up going three wide circling around rivals on the turn, angled to the four path with aim on the front duo turning for home, was relentless in her pursuit outside to the wire and wore down rivals in the in the last few jumps for the win. TEQUILASOUPERNOVA had a tracking role inside another down the back straight, moved closer to hound the pace between rivals around the bend, loomed three wide at the top of the stretch, fought on determinedly with foes on each side staying on the incorrect lead down the lane, poked her head in front briefly at the sixteenth pole but could not fend off the outside late charge by the winner in deep stretch. TABEL had a stalking position ahead of only one runner down the backside, was urged on the turn unable to close the gap on the embattled trio, shifted outside in the two path turning for home, grinded away to the finish line and with a late surge between foes in deep stretch got the nod for the show money at the wire. RARIFIED (IRE) was unhurried at the back of the pack, shifted off the rail in midturn still seeing the field, moved out four wide for the stretch drive and found her best stride late outside rivals to close in belatedly in deep stretch to just miss for the third place share in a tight finish. BRITTANY'S WAY caught a flyer, away alertly to have an early advantage leaving the gate, dictated the pace while prompted outside throughout the turn, was clinging to the front end on the fence at the top of the stretch but needed more in the late running fading slightly at the seventy-yard marker losing a couple of positions late.
