CLASSY IMAGE tracked the pacesetter outside at the half, moved in closing the gap smartly two wide at the quarter pole and with relentless pursuit down the lane wore down the frontrunner in deep stretch. KIKITSA took control from the start, rolled along unopposed throughout the turn, spurted away from the eventual winner in upper stretch but could not find more in the late stages to hold on up top in the final seventy yards still comfortably besting the rest at the wire for the runners up share. IRON PYRITE tracked the leader three deep along the backside, edged nearer, measuring the pacesetter throughout the turn, grinded away three wide down the lane taking the lead over by the sixteenth pole and stubbornly held safely from the closing foe in deep stretch. GENIUS OF LOVE stalked on the rail in the group of three at the rear along the backside, was checked on the fence at the half, dropped back to last entering the turn, made a sharp move passing foes from the rail shifting out four wide at the quarter pole gathering momentum and in the six path down the stretch was closing in, moving to the winner late but could not get there in time. SPEEDY FREEZE settled between rivals in the last group down the backstretch, kept pace three wide in the third flight around the turn, was floated out six wide by the quarter pole, shifted back in to the four path in mid-stretch and got up in the final furlong to close in capturing third money. WILDFIRE became headstrong when in tight behind and between horses in the two path at the half having to be checked for moment, came with a good run shifting off the fence midway around the bend, angled four wide to be in range in early stretch and finished up gradually

between foes to be a fringe player in the end. CHIPOTLE PEPPER emerged from the early scramble up top to have a clear lead on the rail by the five eighths marker, was unchallenged quickening the tempo through the turn, still was holding on to the lead but by a diminishing margin at the furlong pole and emptied out by the seventy yard marker losing many positions late when being engulfed by outside rivals in deep stretch. ROCKET RILEY co-trailed three deep on the outside down the back straight, made no impact outside a runner two wide around the turn, and had to little to show driving in the four path down the stretch. RED MOOD was under a snug hold sitting behind the pacesetter, chased the frontrunner two wide around the turn, had nothing left by the quarter pole and retreated in upper stretch. JUST ON TIME travelled between horses in mid-division down the backside, regressed with runners on either side through the turn to be at the rear by the quarter pole and had no finish to offer in the stretch running.

FAITHFUL CREEK settled in midfield three deep outside foes, made a sharp move with a quick turn of foot four wide at the three eighths pole swooping around the turn to be five wide posing the main threat at the top of the lane, seized command just inside the eighth pole and moved clear drawing of strongly when crossing the finish line. SILENT PATSY vied between runners up top down the back straight, fought for the lead with rivals on both sides throughout the turn, began to edge away from the early speed foes by the quarter pole, braced for yet another challenger at the furlong marker, had no answer when the winner swept past outside at the sixteenth pole but with that gutsy effort managed to clearly hold for the runners up share at the wire. MITOLE POWER travelled on the rail in midfield, took closer order between horses in the two path at the half, kept pace still with runners on either side in the second flight on the turn, shifted out four wide straightening out for the drive and closed belatedly to get up for a non threatening third.LIAM'S AWESOME stalked close to the back of the pack between horses, made little progression ahead of only one runner through the turn, angled out for clear run beginning to reach for more ground seven wide in upper stretch and finished with intent to almost close in late for the show money but had to settle on the fringes in the end. TRICK AND TREAT was situated four deep on the outside tracking the lead trio along the backside, continued to watch the contesting front three wide in the three path between runners having the winner on her outside around the turn, angled out to the six path for the stretch run and finished up mildly passing a couple of runners in deep stretch. SHAMELESS AFFAIR poked her head in front for a moment at the five furlong marker in the mix up top along the backside, battled determinedly on the rail through the turn, was the first of the threesome to give way up front inside foes at the quarter pole and flattened out in the final seventy yards. GATHER had a slim advantage four wide with five runners in the fray up top early on, dueled three wide on the outside of two others at the half, continued the three wide journey dueling outside around the turn, still was in the hunt three wide in upper stretch between horses, could not find another gear late though and folded by the sixteenth pole. CRIMSON NIGHTS was nestled on the fence not too far off the embattled trio at the half, took the short way around the turn making little headway on the lead three and while in the three path turning for home had little to offer in the stretch drive. TACHYON SPEED stalked near the rear in the beginning, trailed the field by the half, could not keep up to rivals losing touch around the turn and could not get involved in the stretch drive.
