OK SPEEDY was nestled on the rail watching the loose leader down the backside, began to reel in the leader midway around the turn, bid for the front in the two path turning for home, seized control outside at the furlong marker and edged away in the final sixteenth drifting to the rail prevailing in deep stretch. TIGER TOWN was loose up top along the backside, freewheeled on the lead with no opposition through the turn, was collared outside by the winner at the furlong marker, fought on stubbornly, gave way inside at the sixteenth pole, shifted outside in the final seventy yards and was actually coming back on nearing the finish line. GEE POWER could see the field at the half, started to mount a rally two wide at the top of the stretch and closed belatedly while not switching leads down the lane to capture the show award in the final seventy yards. J M R SPEEDYVERDIK travelled in the two path in midfield, advanced on the fence with five sixteenths remaining, dueled two wide for third money at the top of the lane, lost the battle late and settled for a minor role in the end. THREE O EIGHT travelled three deep watching the lone speed down the back straight, was roused but could not make any gains on the top two rivals through the turn, shifted out in the five path in the mix for a small share in early stretch but faded, finishing up one paced late. BAPTIST BILLY stalked near the rear three deep, offered a mild run three wide outside rivals with five sixteenth from home, angled out to the six path in upper stretch and finished up evenly on the wrong lead to the wire. GIL'S FOLLY settled close to the back of the pack between foes, improved position at the half, made little progress three wide around the bend, was in with a chance for a minor piece of the prize straightening out for the drive but stalled with a sixteenth of a mile left to run. MARDENE was forced out on the break, tracked the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, rated kindly under a good rhythm waiting for the cue to go on the turn just outside the pacesetter, pounced outside at the top of the lane and drew away convincingly in the late stages for the score. VERI COLLECTED broke outwards on the start, recovered quickly to be alone up top dictating terms down the backside, continued on going comfortably up top around the bend, was headed outside by the winner in upper stretch, could not offer any resistance in the final furlong but ran on to the end besting the rest easily at the finish line. NOYZEE GIRL sat alone in mid-pack, chased the top two runners throughout the turn, continued in vain trying to get to the top pair in the lane, stayed on the right lead to the finish line and settled for a clear but distant third in a strung-out field down the stretch. ROYAL RIBBON travelled three deep close to the back outside foes, kept pace while moving three wide around the bend, offered a mild run four wide turning for home and while angling to the rail at the furlong marker ran on evenly to garner a minor placing in the end. GET OUT THE VOTE was situated on the rail tracking the pacesetter, dropped back on the fence midway on the turn while under a ride and made little presence down the stretch finishing up one paced to the wire. SCAT HUMOR settled on the rail ahead of only the poor starter down the backside, could not go with others through the turn and while on the fence down the lane passed

a weary foe in the final sixteenth of a mile. RY PIE settled in midfield down the back straight, ranged up three wide at the five sixteenths marker outside foes, quickly moved in when under a ride at the

quarter pole, took the lead five wide at the furlong marker and under left handed encouragement still drifted inwards late to hold safe in the two path when crossing the finish line. TODAY stalked down the backside ahead of a couple runners early on, shifted out to the two path splitting horses commencing a run with three eighths to go, had to be checked four wide lacking running room at the quarter pole losing momentum, angled out eight wide getting into gear again in upper stretch and was closing in smartly late but could not get to the winner in time. BEARING DOWN tracked between rivals in the two path down the backside, had a nice position alone watching the contesting trio at the half, improved on the fence throughout the turn, skimmed the rail into early stretch to be in the thick of things at the eighth pole, was in tight on the rail late when the winner was drifting in and just lost the runners up share in the final few strides. HEY CUE was content hounding the pace outside down the backstretch, moved in sharply when coaxed for more gaining outside to take the lead by the quarter pole, angled out four wide travelling strongly in upper stretch and when asked at the furlong marker drew off to win going away. CELENTANO had a good trip in the two path watching the top two down the backside, kept pace in the second flight inside a challenger around the turn, shifted to the three path for the drive, determinedly burst between foes with an eighth still left to run and opened up on horses for the runners up share in the final sixteenth. FRACEN MACHO settled three deep in the middle of the pack along the backside, advanced smartly around horses three wide on the turn to loom the main threat in the five path entering the stretch but could not keep going late and stalled in the final sixteenth of a mile. ROYAL QUALITY rated between runners in midfield, was hard ridden with five sixteenths from home but was losing ground to others, shifted to the three path finishing up on the wrong lead to the wire but found something in reserve to run on late getting up just before the wire to settle on the fringes. PROUD RONIN travelled four deep at the rear in mid-backstretch while unhurried finding his stride, put in a mild rally four wide around horses from the three eighths pole until the quarter marker, swung out to be six wide turning for home and finished up willingly in the stretch run gaining on rivals late. IF YOU INSIST had the advantage up front inside runners

down the backside, was collared by the winner outside with a quarter mile left to run, tried to battle back on the fence in upper stretch but had little left late and wilted in deep stretch. MISTER HOLDEN broke a step slow to trail at the start, was nudged on the fence trying get better inside position down the back straight, had a stalking trip near the rear inside at the half, was scrubbed on the rail narrowing the margin on the leaders around the bend, could not sustain the rally and evened out in deep stretch. MIDNIGHT TEMPESTA settled in midfield early on, had traffic problems in the two path between horses having to be checked out from a tight spot down the backstretch, settled in last making no gains on rivals through the turn, shifted to the four path for the stretch run but offered no finish down the lane.

SEATTLE STINGER was taken a hold of at the start trailing in the beginning, began to make a move passing runners inside at the half, had to be checked nearing the three furlong marker losing all his run, re-rallied strongly four wide between horses at the quarter pole, swung out widest finding his best stride while having a clear lane in the eighth path for the drive and swept on past for the win in deep stretch. MUCHO MAGNIFICO stalked close to the back of the pack in the two path, began to pick up the pace passing horses three wide on the outside three furlongs from the line, was closing in smartly four wide in upper stretch, shifted inwards to the two path making a bid at the eighth pole but was outkicked by the winner in the final sixteenth to finish up second best of this day. SO CALLED VACATION was hustled between runners in the two path watching the pacesetter in the initial bend, chased inside down the backstretch, tracked inside a runner through the last turn, angled out in the five path to be in the conversation at the top of the lane, finished up mildly, gradually gaining on the tiring frontrunner late and held for the show money at the finish line. NIGHT STRIKER travelled three wide on the first turn keeping a close eye on the leader, tracked outside down the backstretch and through the final bend, was in the thick of things six wide turning for home but evened out late to settle for a minor placing in the end. ONE LAST KISS was away alertly leading on the fence loping along taking this field into the first of two turns, quickened the wind aided tempo up top along the backside, still was moving well dictating terms up front on the last turn, began to get leg weary clinging onto the lead four wide in mid-stretch, did not switch leads until late and faded in the last sixteenth. ARRAKASTA IZAN travelled four wide outside foes in mid-division in the first turn, advanced three deep along the backside, edged closer closing in on the far turn, angled seven wide in with a chance straightening out for the drive, shifted in off rivals to the four path in the mix at the furlong marker but could not continue on and levelled off in deep stretch. BLONDINA'S BOY was situated on the rail near the rear in the early stages, offered a brief run commencing at the three furlong marker travelling three wide until the quarter pole in the four path moving the winner to his inside, angled out in the seven path at the top of the stretch but had nothing more to give down the lane. DESROCHERS broke in at the start, tracked three wide between horses in mid-pack on the first bend, improved outside three wide down the back straight, was scrubbed on for more but was going the wrong way with five sixteenths from home and in the two path in the stretch drive could not play a role in the late stages of the race. QUANDALE was brushed between horses on the break, travelled between foes in the two path mid-division in the first bend, made no movement along the backside, could not quicken with others dropping back with three eighths from home and could not get into contention in the two path driving to the wire. TROPICAL GETAWAY settled on the rail in the third tier in the first turn, travelled inside foes on the rail in midfield along the backside, came under a ride at the half but was being passed by runners, could see the field with three eighths remaining and failed to menace three wide between foes in the stretch. MANALUCIUS travelled three wide on the first turn ahead of only the eventual winner, settled in last three deep at the half, made little impression on the far turn and could not get involved five wide in the stretch running. GENTLE PERSUASION had a good spot sitting behind the frontrunner into the first turn, could not maintain forward position on the rail in the backstretch at the five eighths pole, backed away abruptly on the fence midway around the last turn and was not a factor in the stretch drive.
