TUTTI CONTENTI settled four deep watching the lone speed down the backside, moved in to prompt three wide outside foes up top in the turn, loomed a menacing presence five wide in upper stretch and relentlessly wore down the leader in the shadow of the wire for the win. INDY ONE tracked outside three wide with runners on both sides, edged closer two wide between rivals around the turn, seized command poking his head in front at the quarter pole, shifted to the four-path holding the lead in mid-stretch but just missed fending off the winner in the last few strides. BEE ME travelled in mid-division three wide between horses, mounted a rally three around foes five sixteenths from the wire, was reaching for more ground in the four-path straightening out for home, switched leads nearing the sixteenth pole and found more late to surge in the final seventy yards to capture the show money. DEMBA tracked the pacesetter in the two path between rivals, kept pace between runners in the second tier around the bend to be in range three wide at the top of the lane, battled for the show award in the stretch but evened out late to settle on the fringes. BARONS BLITZ had a stalking position close to the back of the pack on the rail, began to pick up runners shifting out between horses midway on the turn, swung out four wide taking closer order behind the dueling leaders in upper stretch and was gradually gaining on rivals in the end. TRUE SHOT was unhurried trailing down the back straight, still could see the field but was

narrowing the margin on rivals around the bend, angled three wide for the drive to the wire and with late interest was closing in on horses late but could not improve position at the finish line. BIG LEW stalked in midfield three wide between foes in the beginning, was shuffled back midway along the backside, offered a brief turn of foot two wide at the three-furlong pole through the turn to be six wide turning for home in with a chance, could not continue the rally outside and had no finish in the final furlong. SPECIAL ELEMENT sat just behind the leader along the backstretch, was nudged three eighths out but could not quicken with others making a move outside, backed away on the fence while under a ride through the turn and could not factor in the stretch running. LOST STAR was hustled taking command from the onset, rattled along unchallenged up top entering the turn, was collared outside at the quarter pole, offered no resistance on the fence by upper stretch and retreated on the rail down the lane.

REVERSE PSYCHOLOGY emerged from the early scramble to have a slim lead over four others at the five furlong pole, rolled along comfortably up top through the turn, sputred away from the chasing foe turning for home and coasted home for the impressive score. CLOUD RIDER stalked near the rear, commenced a run on the fence at the three furlong pole, had to be geared down for a moment stuck briefly behind a faded rival in midturn, shifted out two wide between horses at the quarter pole, started up again to be full of run late in the two path, could not reel in the winner who was long gone but did easily best the rest for the second position. ARCTIC BLONDE had a stalking position ahead of only one runner down the backside, settled at the rear in the two path three eighths out, uncorked a run around horses three wide at the quarter pole, found her best stride late in the five path through the stretch and closed in late to capture the show money in the final few jumps. LINDA'S OPAL was in a good spot with a half mile to run alone watching the contesting trio, moved in closer two wide with five sixteenths from the wire to be in range in the three path in upper stretch but could only finish up mildly down the lane to garner a minor placing in the end. PRETTY GOOD JOKE prompted the lead three deep down the backside, chased the frontrunning winner in vain throughout the turn, was clinging onto the runners up share three wide in mid-stretch but yielded between rivals in the final seventy yards. BLUE SPIRIT was allowed to settle at the back of the pack in the early stages, had a smart turn of foot around the turn picking up horses outside, battled for the minor share four wide at the top of the lane, could not sustain the rally and stalled at the furlong marker. ZIPFIRE pressed the issue between runners down the backside, could not maintain forward position with runners on either side up top going into the turn, regressed on the fence around the bend and had little to offer on the rail down the stretch. SOCIAL DANCER travelled on the rail in midfield, took an awkward step nearing the half mile pole, was eased, pulling up at the five

sixteenth marker and left via equine ambulance.

EARHART (FR) assumed command moving well up front down the backside, edged away with the rider statuesque throughout the turn, opened up with ease at the top of the stretch and cruised in for the impressive win while only under a hand ride. **SHE LOVES** settled at the rear in the early going, began to lengthen stride outside rivals midway around the turn, made a strong move swooping around foes at the quarter pole, angled four wide for the drive and finished up second best with that solid debut behind the dominant winner. **STOLEN VALOUR** tracked three wide in mid-pack with runners on either side, took up the chase three wide at the half, was urged on the turn but could not narrow the gap on the winner around the bend and finished up willingly through the lane holding on to be a clear third at the wire. **QUEST TO BE PROUD** rated between horses in the two path in mid-division, closed the gap smartly on the fence in midturn, skimmed the rail entering the stretch and was one paced inside foes to be a fringe player in the end. **CLEARWATER BEACH** travelled four deep in the middle of the pack early on, made a quick spurt moving up a few positions to watch the top two runners with three furlongs to go, was in the mix three wide for a piece of the prize in upper stretch, could not find more late and faded between horses at the furlong marker. **SPELLCHECK** broke out on the break, was nestled on the fence in a tight group midfield down the backside, had to be checked briefly on the fence at the seven sixteenths marker being shuffled back, made little impact around the turn and could not factor in the stretch running. **CANDY ROSE** was brushed inside on the start, stalked ahead one runner while behind a wall of runners down the backside, had a short spurt three wide around a couple of horses at the three eighths pole and in the three path could not rally to get into contention in the drive to the wire. **LASTMAMBO IN PARIS** was content to track the frontrunner outside in the beginning, could not keep up with others when scrubbed on for more going in the wrong direction at the three furlong pole, lost touch with the field turning for home and cantered down the stretch to the finish line.

DREXEL HILL rated kindly between runners keeping a close eye on the front pair down the backside, ranged up three wide moving in at the five sixteenths pole, posed the only threat while in the three path turning for home, took over control by the eighth pole and opened up at will in the last furlong for the convincing win. SCAT GIRL veered in at the start to trail in the early stages, started to gather speed skimming the rail at the top of the stretch and with a strong late kick moved in to be a distant second but comfortably bested others for the runners up share at the wire. NORTH YORK had a tracking role in the second flight on the rail, was hard ridden but was dropping back midway around the turn, angled three wide in upper stretch, dug back in finding more at the eighth pole and rebid late to capture the show award. TANDHONEYWITHANE stalked near the back of the pack while on the fence, closed the gap mildly in the two path between runners on the turn, angled five wide at the top of the lane and finished up with good energy for a minor placing outside foes. SOUPER ZESTY ZEST travelled three deep tracking the lead duo, tried to go with the eventual winner inside when roused four wide midway through the turn but could only finish up evenly posing little threat in the four path driving to the finish line. KEYTOTHEPARK pulled the rider to the front, had company up top inside at the five furlong pole, battled outside around the behind for the top spot, maintained a slim lead in the two path with the winner closing in outside in upper stretch and wilted under the pressure in the final furlong. FORESTERS EXEC tracked the leader in the beginning, moved in to duel for the lead inside at the five eighths pole, continued to fight on having the rail throughout the turn, had little left for the stretch run and folded on the fence at the furlong marker. STREET PRINCESS broke a step slow ahead of only the other poor starter along the backside, kept pace travelling three wide around the turn, angled out six wide for the drive to the wire but lacked a rally down the stretch.

MEAN TO ME bumped a rival at the start, was forwardly-positioned but steadied slightly just past the five-eighths, began to

advance three to four wide on the turn, gained steadily in the stretch but was not enough. SILENT SUNSHINE sped clear setting the pace inside just off the rail, was collared a sixteenth out and had no extra. SNATCHED was lightly bumped at the start, outpaced early racing at the back, was mostly three to five wide throughout, urged along coming to the of the stretch, finished strongest of all to rally between foes but was too late. MISTY EYED was brushed at the start, chased the leader mostly four then five wide floating out a bit into upper stretch, kept on late but was not enough. SILENT STRIKE stumbled soon after the start, faced traffic in the early going, switched outside foes up the backstretch, was mostly five to six wide from that point on shifting eight wide into upper stretch, finished up with mild late gain but needed more. ZIPPY GAMBLE appeared to brush the gate and inside foe lightly at the start, had good forward position tracking inside, came out four wide turning for home and within range but could not sustain the effort and flattened out. BLACK DAGGER was in tight quarters past the seven-sixteenths racing at the back, faced mild traffic into the turn, improved position in the stretch. MARYLAND SPIRIT appeared to brush the gate and outside rival lightly at the start, raced at the back inside foes, was off the rail into the stretch, failed to menace. FEW GOOD STORIES chased mostly four to five wide, was under urging past the seven-sixteenths, faded. MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY broke outwardly, was never near the leaders dropping back further while four to five wide on the turn, failed to thraeten.

VERDEJO could see the field while three deep down the backside, began to pick up the bit at the midpoint around the turn, burst between rivals in the five path in early stretch, switched leads at the eighth pole finding another gear and finished up strongly late to be a clear third when crossing the finish. HAPPY VALENTINE was tucked in on the fence watching the front duo down the back straight, continued to keep tabs on the

contesting pair in midturn, shifted three wide for the stretch run to be in the thick of things at the top of the lane but stalled late holding for only a minor share in the end. AWASEF broke out on the start, stalked outside a runner in the second to last group along the backside, made little movement three wide through the turn, angled out six wide at the top of the stretch and passed a few tired rivals down the lane to the finish line. LIVIN ON LUV tracked between horses in the two path, could not accelerate with runners on both sides when they were making a move at the three eighths pole, dropped back around the bend and was one paced in the three path down the stretch. MISS VYVYANNE was bounced around between horses on the start, rushed up after the compromised start to take control outside by the five furlong pole setting a brisk pace down the backside, was collared outside with five sixteenths from home, offered little resistance on the fence by the top of the stretch and stopped at the furlong marker. CHROMEPLATED HEART was squeezed on the break, recouped to track three deep outside foes along the backside, was roused two wide in midturn trying to keep up to the leaders, had little left for the drive and tired at the furlong marker.

STORMCAST broke sharp at the start, seized command on the rail entering the backstretch, improved the advantage unopposed at the half, was nudged for more at the quarter pole when rivals were attempting to close in, spurted away by mid-stretch and was kept to the task late to hold safe but by a diminishing margin in the end. LOVE TO SHOP was brushed inside on the start, settled in midfield three wide between horses, mounted a rally four wide around foes at the quarter pole, angled to the six path with her sights set on the leader in upper stretch, closed in sharply, moving to the winner late but could not get there in time. TRIPOLINA was brushed inside on the break, co-trailed on the outside down the back straight, started to pick up speed angling out three wide in midturn, was full of run widest in the seven path having a clear lane in upper stretch and with a strong late charge closed in to capture the show award right at the wire in a tight photo. STORM MIAMI (IRE) travelled three wide between horses watching the lead duo along the backside, kept pace with the leaders three wide on the turn while in the second flight, closed in three wide at the quarter pole to be in the hunt five wide at the top of the lane, finished up with energy late but just missed holding for the show money right at the wire. STAR CANDY was away alertly on the start, settled in to have a stalking role close to the back between foes down the backside, waited for the cue to go with runners on either side in the third tier around the bend, looked for a seam while four wide turning for home, finally had a clear path at the furlong marker and was running on end smartly at the finish but was on the wrong end of the three way photo for third place. A GAME settled between horses in the third grouping at the half, was nudged for more keeping pace with the leaders through the turn to be in range two wide at the top of the stretch but could only finish up mildly on the fence in the final furlong posing little threat late. TITO'S CALLING co-trailed on the inside early on, shifted out two wide midway around the turn commencing a run, angled out six wide straightening out for home and managed to pass a couple of weary foes down the stretch. METAPHYSICAL had a slim lead outside leaving the chute, chased the pacesetter outside down the back straight, continued in vain trying to get to the leader throughout the turn, angled out three wide for the drive holding for the place share but yielded in the final sixteenth of a mile. GAL IN A RUSH stalked on the rail ahead of a couple of rivals, settled on the fence in the third flight waiting for room around the bend, lacked running room three wide behind foes in upper stretch, still was blocked with an eighth remaining and could not offer a finish due to traffic problems in deep stretch. QUEEN MACHA stalked in the third tier on the rail down the backside, took the shortest way around following the leader on the turn, had little for the stretch drive and retreated at the furlong marker. SPANSIVE refused on the break and walked off. OWEN'S TOUR GUIDE hopped and tossed her head at the start, tracked the top two foes four deep along the backside, settled in the third flight four wide outside horses around the turn, took a misstep at the quarter pole, fell, dislodging the rider and left via equine ambulance.
