REGAL GUEST tracked four deep on the outside watching the frontrunner patiently in hand down the back straight, travelled three wide measuring the leader on the turn, moved to when nudged at the quarter pole to pose the main threat three wide by upper stretch and switched leads with a furlong remaining to draw off smartly in deep stretch. LITTLE THONIO was off slowly on the break, settled into stride narrowing the margin in the two path between foes along the backside, edged closer with runners on either side through the turn, rallied on the rail in upper stretch, shifted out three wide at the furlong marker and determinedly won the duel for the runners up share holding on late. GLINTINDADDYSEYE watched the front quartet when leaving the chute, dropped back while under a ride with a half mile to run, began to reach for more ground three wide in midturn, circled four wide around foes at the quarter pole and closed belatedly down the lane to just miss getting up for the place share at the finish line. MAGIC POWER was washy prior to the start, brushed inside on the break, tracked three wide between horses in the early going, poked his head in front by the three eighths pole, was collared outside by the winner in upper stretch, offered little resistance with a furlong left to run and faded late to settle for a minor share in the end. CRUCIAL TAUNT stalked near the rear four wide outside foes, closed the gap outside rivals down the backstretch, kept pace going three wide around the bend and could only finish up one paced in the lane from the three path in upper stretch to finish up on the rail at the wire. DILWAALA chased the pace on the rail in the beginning, could not go on with the lead group by the half, travelled in the wrong direction taking the short way around the turn and failed to menace in the drive to the wire. ROYAL FONZ broke out at the start, pulled the rider to seize command entering the backstretch, gave way up top to the stablemate at the three furlong marker, backed away through the field on the fence around the turn and could not factor in the stretch running. REALLOVEISLUCKY was allowed to settle seeing the field at the half, was scrubbed three eighths out but could not make any impression losing touch with rivals around the bend and galloped down the stretch to the finish line.

SLOANS SKY was ahead of one runner down the backside, circled around rivals four wide at the quarter pole lengthening stride, angled out widest in the seven path at the top of the lane and with a solid late charge from the outside closed in on the winner late but ended up second best on this day. LOOKHOWPRETTY was slow into stride seeing the field along the backside, mounted a rally angling outside three wide with five sixteenths to go to pick up rivals outside by the quarter pole, was full of run six wide turning for home and was gaining sharply on the top two late but finished up a clear third at the finish line. BRAQUET stalked close to the back between foes in the two path, commenced a rally picking up the bit between horses moving well in hand on the turn, found a clear lane three wide straightening out for home and tenaciously wore down the leader in the shadow of the wire for the win. HOLIDAY WITH AMY settled on the rail in midfield, advanced inside foes at the half, travelled on the fence watching the pacesetter around the bend, moved in to bid just outside the frontrunner in upper stretch, poked her head in front for a moment with seventy yards to go but could not fend off the relentless winner late. EMPTY GESTURE pulled the rider to the lead into the backstretch, dictated terms unopposed through the turn, was clinging onto the front while inside foes at the

top of the stretch and gave way grudgingly inside the top two finishers in the final seventy yards to be a clear third in the end. FIGHTER IN THE WIN was hard held watching the lone speed in the early going, began to reel in the frontrunner with five sixteenths to go, seized control inside runners in upper stretch and fought on gamely down the lane to hold on at the finish line to share in the victory in the end. SWAGGISH settled on the inside in the third flight down the backside, had a good turn of foot moving closer in the two path by the quarter pole, posed the main threat three wide between runners straightening out for the stretch run and battled throughout the lane to get up right on the line to be a co-winner at the wire. LOBBY BAR travelled on the rail in mid-pack, waited for running room on the rail around the far turn, shifted two wide finding a seam in upper stretch, burst between horses gaining third at the furlong pole and held on for third place from an outside foe charging late. PAINTTHETOWNSILVER settled stalking outside mid-pack, was mostly four to seven wide throughout, advanced outside in upper stretch taking the lead between the eighth and sixteenth poles, held off an inside challenger to prevail under steady handling. PRICELESS WILL broke outwardly, settled near the inside well back, angled five to six wide in upper stretch, bid in between runners past the eighth pole in tandem with the winner, couldn't get past that one and was held off to be second best. AMERICAN DECISION settled off the pace shifting in, saved ground on the turn, came out near mid-stretch, rallied six wide between runners to get up for show honors. MOON LANDING was in just a hair tight after the start, settled off the pace, moved out from three to five wide on the turn, swung out further eight wide in upper stretch, kicked on mildly but was outfinished for show. PINE KNOLL stalked in behind racing in the second flight outside a runner, was mostly three to four wide in the early going and on the turn, tucked inside foes a bit in the stretch in range of the leaders, evened out late. GREAT KATE settled outside a rival tracking the front pair in the early stages, moved in with runners on both sides at the quarter pole to be in the thick of things five wide at the top of the stretch, got to the lead between rivals four wide with horses five abreast at the sixteenth pole and prevailed at the wire getting her head down right at the line to save for the win from the oncoming challenger outside. AIN'T NO LADY was ahead of only the poor starter going into the first of two turns, settled in last inside a rival by the half mile pole, had a quick turn of foot when roused at the five sixteenths marker, shifted out four wide gathering more speed at the quarter pole, carried that momentum in the seven path in upper stretch and while staying on the incorrect lead closed in to just miss the nod for the win at the wire. ZONING ORDER was nestled on the rail watching the top two runners, narrowed the margin when nudged for more

midway around the last turn, angled to the three path in upper stretch, was coming on between horses at the sixteenth pole but was outkicked by the top two finishers in the final seventy yards. CINNAMON BITS travelled three wide into the first turn while in mid-pack, made no movement outside foes down the backstretch, rallied three wide at the quarter pole to be in range in the six path turning for home, kept on coming down the lane to be in the hunt with a sixteenth left to run but evened out late posing no threat in the end. BLACKDIAMOND DINNY tracked the frontrunner in the beginning stages, moved in to apply pressure outside with three furlongs left to run, dueled outside for the front through the far turn, edged away while on the wrong lead at the furlong marker, switched leads late but still wilted inside foes in deep stretch. BRAVO KATE settled on the rail in midfield, stalked near the rear down the backside, came under a ride on the fence midway on the final bend closing the gap on the leaders, had a chance in the two path for a share at the furlong marker but could not go on with others late, levelling off in deep stretch. MAGIC MODIE assumed the lead into the first turn, continued unchallenged up top along the back straight, was headed outside with three furlongs remaining, battled on the rail for the lead in the far turn, fought on stubbornly on the fence until the eighth pole but faltered in deep stretch. SAVE THE DATE tracked outside watching the front two down the back straight, closed in on the leader by midturn, loomed boldly five wide between horses in upper stretch, took control at the sixteenth pole and was going away for the win when crossing the finish line. NO LAYUPS was away quickly taking the field up front down the backside, opened up briefly in midturn, still maintained a slim advantage inside from the winner at the furlong pole, was no match in deep stretch but did stay on determinedly to best the rest at the finish line. SILENT PASSION travelled outside in midfield, made little impact three wide around the bend, angled out six wide for the drive then shifted inwards to the four path finding more at the furlong marker and surged late to close in a capture the show money in a photo at the wire. BOSITANIA had a tracking role on the rail keeping a close eye on the lead pair down the backside, was roused on the fence keeping pace with the frontrunner midway around the bend, shifted out three wide at the top of the lane, was fighting on stubbornly inside horses to the wire moving in late but was on the wrong end of a three way photo for the place/show awards and settled for a minor role in the end. FEATHERWEIGHT travelled in midfield down the backstretch, had to be throttled down momentarily when stuck behind a tiring foe in midturn, rallied three wide having room at the quarter pole to be in the mix six wide turning for home but could not find more late and stalled in the final seventy yards. MADAM GWEN co-trailed on the outside at the half mile marker, chose the overland route making a quick move around foes four wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the nine path straightening out for the drive to the wire and still kept on coming through the lane to be gaining on runners in deep stretch while not that far beaten for the minor placings at the wire. POWAQA stalked on the rail ahead of a couple of rivals with a half mile remaining, waited behind a runner on the fence in the turn at the quarter pole, shifted out three wide finding a seam in upper stretch but had no finish to offer when clear in the late stages. SILENT DIVA co-trailed on the rail at the half, made a brief run four wide between horses at the top of the lane dueling for the minors until the eighth pole but weakened in deep stretch. ON PARADISE HILL tracked on the outside in the third flight down the backside, edged closer when scrubbed on four wide at the quarter pole, angled out in the five path under left-handed encouragement in upper stretch, was steadied losing its path four wide just inside the eighth pole and could not recover late.
