PEACE POSEY was tucked in on the rail under a snug hold sitting behind the pacesetter, had a good spot all alone measuring the dueling pair midway around the final bend, loomed five wide in upper stretch, battled outside up front at the sixteenth pole and inched away between rivals for the win nearing the wire. SHINIGAMI stalked near the rear in the two path between horses, advanced down the backside to sit in the third tier between runners, began to pick up the bit when scrubbed on with three furlongs to go, took closer order through the turn to be in range six wide in early stretch, was gaining smartly on the embattled duo at the eighth pole, switched back to the wrong led drifting in for a few strides at the sixteenth pole, resurged late going to the correct lead but could not get there in time. DARK THOUGHTS was content to track the frontrunner on the outside, edged up to hound the pace outside down the back

straight, poked his head in front midway around the last turn, edged away three wide at the top of the stretch, dueled inside with a sixteenth remaining but just got a little leg weary late settling for the show money while not being beaten all that far in the end. AUDAX MINOR travelled three wide ahead of only the poor starter in the beginning, co-trailed inside at the half, made no progression two wide behind horses on the last bend, shifted out four wide turning for home, had his best stride late and closed in for a minor placing. MAD CHATTER sat by himself in midfield, put in a mild run four wide outside foes on the final turn, angled out seven wide for the stretch drive, did not switch leads down the lane and finished up one paced to the wire. CHARTED MAP assumed the front setting a soft pace early on, continued to dictate the pace setting an even tempo along the backside, was hard ridden trying to keep the lead inside with five sixteenths left to run, stayed on determinedly on the fence until the eighth pole but folded in deep stretch. CALLING HOME bobbled slightly on the break trailing into the initial turn, improved four deep entering the backstretch, was once again relegated to the rear co-trailing outside at the half, made little impact four wide on the far turn and could no factor in the stretch running. MINE SEEKER tracked outside watching the top two runners, could not quicken with others at the three-furlong pole, retreated in the three path through the turn and emptied out at the top of the lane. AIM DON'T MISS trailed the field with five furlongs from home, edged up to be in the third flight on the rail at the half, offered a mild run for a brief moment on the fence at the five sixteenths marker but had nothing to offer on the rail in upper stretch.

BREAK THE SPELL settled into stride stalking near the rear ahead of only the poor starter, began to reach for more ground circling smoothly outside horses three wide at the three eighths pole, had a full head of steam seven wide by the top of the stretch, swept past powerfully to seize command at the furlong marker and was kept to the task late to hold safe from the oncoming late surge by the runner up. COLONEL MUSTARD hopped at the start trailing down the backside, continued to see the field around the bend, swung out widest in the eight path, was flying outside horses late but just could not get to the winner in time. ARASHI travelled in midfield in the two path, had to be geared down stuck behind a tiring foe with three furlongs remaining, waited throughout the turn behind rivals, found a seam three wide at the top of the lane and ran on willingly in deep stretch to be a clear third at the finish line. ENCHANT ME improved on the rail along the backside, closed in smartly on the fence throughout the turn, bid for the lead poking his head in front for a moment in mid-stretch but faded in the final seventy yards to settle on the fringes in the end. SUPER SICILY was roused getting to the lead from the outside, opened up heading into the turn, set a quick pace around the bend but was leading by a diminishing margin when turning for home, battled briefly three wide between foes in upper

stretch but had little left in reserve late and gave way in the final furlong. MO TOURIST settled in mid-pack with runners on both sides while in the three path, dropped back at the half, made little headway on the last turn, shifted in from the four path in upper stretch to the rail by the furlong marker but could not get into contention in the stretch drive. VALLEY VICTORY pressed the issue inside in the beginning, chased the frontrunner on the rail by the half, was scrubbed on trying to maintain his spot through the turn three wide between foes, shifted to the five path in upper stretch but faltered in the drive to the wire. QUIET INTENT travelled in mid-division four deep on the outside, kept pace still having a four wide journey outside horses around the bend, angled out to the seven path straightening out for home but lacked a rally down the lane. ADELAIDE COURT was reined in watching the lead two speed foes into the backstretch, fought the rider's restraint climbing at the half mile pole, came under a ride three wide between rivals on the turn closing the gap, angled out six wide for the drive but yielded in mid-stretch.

LUMBERYARD was away alertly for a slim lead outside down the backstretch, continued to battle up front outside around the turn for the top spot, relinquished the front four wide at the top of the lane, dug in stubbornly chasing the winner to the wire and stayed on to best the rest in the end. MAP'S A BREEZE broke in at the start, settled in midfield between foes three wide down the back straight, ran evenly in the two path throughout the turn, mounted a rally two wide at the furlong marker and with one final surge got up on the fence at the finish line to win the show award in a photo. HIGHLAND BLUE was squeezed hard between rivals at the break, recouped to track the contesting duo outside a rival along the backside, kept pace with the lead two around the bend, shifted out five wide in the mix in upper stretch, drifted inwards dueling for the show money at the eighth pole and just missed holding for third place at the wire. DRAW BOOT travelled four deep in mid-division down the backside, closed the gap outside going four wide around horses in the turn, shifted out to the six path turning for home but failed to be a menace in the stretch running. BEYOND ADVERSITY settled close to the back of the pack running on the fence, stalked in the third flight on the rail saving all the ground through the bend, shifted out to the two path by mid-stretch off a tiring foe but failed to fire in the late stages. RAYMORE broke out on the start, tracked the engaged pair on the rail in the early stages, moved in taking the short way around the turn to be in the hunt on the fence in upper stretch, had little left when asked for more at the furlong marker and was not persevered with late. AWMIK SIDE OF TOWN stalked near the rear travelling three deep, dropped back to last at the three-furlong m

CHURCH AND STATE hesitated on the start to co-trail on the inside, advanced in hand on the rail three furlongs from the wire, shifted out four wide making a sharp move around foes at the quarter pole, loomed a menacing presence in the six path at the top of the stretch, seized control by the furlong marker and opened up when crossing the finish line. SPECIAL SESSION hopped on the break, tried to improve on the rail down the backside but was checked inside the five eighths marker, settled in the third flight inside horses at the half, shifted outside have clear run three wide at the three furlong marker to commence a run, ranged up to pose a threat five wide straightening out for home but was outfinished by the winner in the final furlong to be second best on this day. HUMAN DESIRE was bumped on the start, recovered to track the lead pair on the rail by the half, waited patiently behind the contesting leaders around the bend, found a seam three wide in upper stretch, lost its path and had to be steadied sharply when on heels at the furlong marker and showed resiliency to come back nearing the finish to capture third money on the line. WAR WARRIOR broke in at the start, had a slim lead outside down the backstretch, dueled outside up top at the half, regained the front spot by the quarter pole outside, drifted out a lane in the three path trying to hold onto the lead at the eighth

pole and faded late being caught at the wire for the show money. SOUPED UP contently tracked the lone speed in the two path with runners on either side down the back straight, crept closer keeping tabs on the pacesetter in the turn, moved in to bid three wide at the top of the lane, was encouraged right handed at the sixteenth pole and edged away for the win in deep stretch. MAAKWA broke sharp clearing from the outer post to get to the rail for the lead by the five eighths marker, continued to roll along unchallenged around the turn, was clinging onto the leader with the winner bearing down outside in upper stretch, gave way grudgingly inside at the sixteenth pole and still stayed on determinedly for the runners up share. BOSTON TEA PARTY broke in at the start to co-trail on the outside at the half,

stalked at the rear around the turn closing the gap on the leaders by the time they entered the stretch, burst up the rail finding a seam at the furlong marker and shifted just outside in the final seventy yards to capture the third-place share. FORESTER'S FORTUNE settled in the middle of the pack inside runners in the two path along the backside, kept pace on the fence when nudged on through the turn, rallied two wide at the top of the stretch, shifted to the three path at the sixteenth pole but lost the duel for the show money late. OLD CHESTNUT travelled in midfield between foes three wide, was looking for running room behind rivals in the two path through the turn, angled out to the five path having no lane behind horses in upper stretch, shifted out seven wide at the furlong marker finally getting clear and flew home late outside rivals in deep stretch. AIR COMBAT was tucked in on the rail tracking the frontrunner down the backside, patiently waited for the cue on the fence sitting behind the leaders around the bend, shifted off three wide from the dueling pair in mid-stretch but lacked a bid in the late stages of the race. GIANT TEDDY stumbled on the break to co-trail on the rail at the half, started a rally four wide at the quarter pole, angled seven wide in the stretch run and could only run on gradually down the lane stalling in the final seventy yards. RAPID GREY tracked between foes three wide, chased the lead duo while between rivals in the two path around the bend, had a chance for a small share three wide turning for home but could not offer a finish in the last eighth of a mile. LIGHT THE LAMP travelled four deep on the outside watching the frontrunner, tracked the top two while three wide on the outside through the turn, was in touch if good enough in the four path at the top of the lane but did not have enough late to threaten in deep stretch. ROI SOLEIL stalked four deep on the outside ahead of only the poor starters along the backside, put in a mild run three wide outside rivals in the turn t

BABBO made a three wide move from mid-pack getting a better forward position at the half to track the frontrunner outside, measured the lone speed while moving in comfortably around the turn, pounced four wide in early stretch, switched leads when tapped right-handed at the eighth pole to open up smartly and held safe for the win when crossing the finish line. ARABIAN PRINCE stalked close to the back of the pack in front of a couple runners down the back straight. started to rally three wide outside foes at the three furlong pole, continued to swoop outside of runners in the turn to be seven wide in upper stretch gaining more speed, had another gear when asked for more at the furlong pole and finished up strongly to be a solid runner up with that turn move. WARHOL sat behind the quick early pace on the fence, settled on the rail in the third flight watching the lead pair around the turn, was hard ridden trying to reel in the leaders at the quarter pole, chased the winner in vain in upper stretch, moved into the place share by the sixteenth pole but was caught late and settled for a clear third in the end. FAIRWAY TO HEAVEN travelled outside in the third tier in the early stages, shifted to the five path to be in the hunt for a piece of the prize in upper stretch, could not go with the top two in the final furlong but still finished up willingly to the wire capturing a minor role at the finish line. ROAR OF THE CROWD was under a snug hold on the inside near the rear down the backside, improved on the rail midway around the bend, was checked in tight quarters skimming the fence turning for home, rallied up the rail at the furlong pole but levelled off in deep stretch. PROCTOR PHANTOM was unhurried to co-trail on the outside four furlongs from home, took closer order running outside a fellow rival on the turn, shifted to the four path at the top of the lane, darted inside off a tiring runner at the eighth pole and finished up with good intent in deep stretch. HAVE IT MY WAY sat alone in midfield with a half mile remaining, made little movement when scrubbed on between runners around the bend, angled to the four path in the stretch run but could only finish up mildly to the wire. SOUTHERN STYLE brushed the outside part of the gate on the break to co-trail on the inside at the half mile marker, saved ground narrowing the margin on the leaders through the turn, shifted three wide for the stretch drive, was checked briefly losing his path just inside the furlong marker and recovered to pass some runners in deep stretch. MAGIC SLIPS stalked outside in the two path ahead a few rivals down the backstretch, made little impact two wide though the turn, angled out to be in the six path straightening out for home but had little to show in the drive to the wire. BANKINGONAMIRACLE was loose on the lead down the backside, rattled along setting a fast pace up top around the turn, was collared outside by the winner in upper stretch and stopped in the two path in the final seventy yards. HAWKESBURY broke out on the start, travelled four deep in mid-division along the backside, offered a brief turn of foot three wide at the three eighths pole around foes to be six wide at the top of the stretch, could not continue the rally and tired with a furlong left to run.
