LITERATE was knocked off stride by the inside foe on the start, settled in the two path closely watching the front two holding her own around the first turn, had a good spot down the backside nestled on the fence drafting behind the engaged leaders, waited to cue to move on the rail in the far turn, skimmed the fence to be in the thick of things at the top of the stretch, squeezed through to seize command by the sixteenth pole and edged away for the win under a ground saving trip. FORTYFIVESEVENTY had a stalking role going four wide around horses in the first bend, tracked the lead twosome three deep on the outside down the backstretch, continued wide around the second turn in the three path keeping pace with the group, angled out in the four path having a clear lane in early stretch and determinedly fought on late to be second best with the game stretch effort. SIX SENSE was content to hound the pace outside in the early stages, still applied pressure outside dueling up front around the last bend, shifted out to the four path in the hunt up top in mid-stretch drifted in a touch driving the wire late but was outkicked by the top two finishers while just saving for the show award. AWESOME SPIRIT GAL (FR) stalked three wide between horses in the initial turn, tracked the lead two with runners on either side down the back straight, had a seam in the three path to be in the mix in upper stretch, was checked losing her path just inside the furlong marker and tenaciously resurged to get a minor role while not being beaten all that much for the place share as well. WICKENHEISER broke out on the start, was in tight on the fence behind the pacesetter trying to maintain inside position with three outside foes bearing in around the first turn, was reined back by the half to see the compact field down the backside, had to take the overland route behind a wall of three runners going four wide at the quarter pole, tried to get the jump on horses on the outside turning for home while range five wide in upper stretch, could not continue the run and needed more in the late stages to factor in the end. GILD THE LILY assumed the lead on the rail setting a soft pace into the first of two turns, continued up front while shadowed outside down the backstretch, maintained a slim advantage with the field basically six abreast at the top of the stretch, could not find another gear late and yielded to rivals in the last sixteenth of a mile.

EMERALD LAKE broke in at the start, rated kindly watching the lead trio in the two path down the backstretch, tracked the contesting pair outside around the bend, moved in three wide at the quarter pole to pose the main threat entering the lane and stubbornly wore down the pacesetter in the shadow of the wire for the victory. AIRY FAIRY was away alertly taking the lead, had company to her outside at the quarter pole, maintained a slim advantage in the two path at the top of the lane, spurted away at the eighth pole but could not fend off the relentless pursuit from the winner nearing the finish line. GIZMO'S B F

F travelled outside foes in mid-division down the backside rating kindly under a good hold, closed the gap outside horses on the turn, shifted four wide in early stretch and with a strong late surge almost got up for the runners up share at the wire. REMEMBERING RHODA was bumped outside on the start, recovered to settle in mid-pack inside horses in the backstretch, edged up the fence around the turn, shifted to the three path straightening for home and ran on willingly for a minor placing in the end. CRUMLIN BIRD tracked outside in the second flight, took closer order to sit just off the flank of the frontrunner in midturn, bid for the lead three wide in upper stretch, could not find another gear late and stalled between rivals in the last furlong. DIFFERENT DRUM broke inwards and was jostled between rivals on the break, co-trailed outside four deep down the backstretch, improved three wide on the outside through the turn, was fanned out in the six path at the tip of the lane and had good late energy gaining on runners to the wire. KANTBACKOFF was in the last group three wide between rivals along the backside, put in a mild run when roused at the quarter pole three wide between horses, shifted out five wide for the stretch run and finished with interest through the stretch. SPEEDY RIVER was under a snug hold settling behind the pacesetter on the fence down the back straight, patiently sat on the rail behind the engaged leaders waiting to move through the turn, took the short route hugging the inside turning for home to be in the hunt in upper stretch but failed to fire in the late stages. WINYAH BAY stalked on the rail in the rear foursome down the backside, was roused on the fence in midturn offering little response and could not get involved in the drive to the finish line. LULU'S LULLABY co-trailed in mid-backstretch in the two path between foes, was scrubbed on but could not keep up to others around the bend and played no factor in the stretch running.

SAILOR'S PASSION stalked near the rear on the inside, sat patiently behind a wall of runners at the half, mounted a rally shifting out three wide midway around the last turn, swept around horses six wide gathering more speed at the top of the lane and edged away for the win in the final seventy yards. SOUPER WATSON tracked the pacesetter outside in the first turn, was eager closing the margin outside along the backside, bid for the front outside foes three furlongs out, took over control midway on the last bend, had company outside clinging to the lead at the quarter pole, dug in stubbornly inside rivals down the lane, was no match for the winner late but did valiantly save the place share at the wire. GRANDE SOIREE stalked close to the back outside the eventual winner, made an early move progressing three wide outside runners at the half, circled the field beginning at the three furlong pole three wide to be up front in the five path at the top of the stretch, dueled down the stretch while not switching leads until the sixteenth pole when the winner went by outside but did fight back late to almost come on again for the place share in the end. GO JIMMY GO bumped a rival lightly at the start, settled mid-pack two to three wide, came out and was forced out at the top of the stretch bumping the outside rival, fought gamely four to five wide between foe the place. SHADOW REALM was bumped at the start, chased from off the inside three to four deep, floated out and was bumped at the top of the stretch, contended for second outside runners but was outfinished. ENDURING tracked four wide outside runners in the first turn, advanced three deep pulling the rider in early backstretch, settled into stride watching the lead duo at the half, ranged up three wide two furlongs out, bid for the lead in the four path turning for home and determinedly between horses prevailed in a stretch battle by a slim margin at the finish line. GOOD AS GONE broke in on the start but was quickly corrected, dropped back to be part of the final group at the rear with a half mile to run, angled out four wide at the quarter pole reaching for more ground, came with a charge six wide down the lane and just missed with a final push at the wire. MY GIRL DELLA had a slim lead on the fence into the first of two turns, set the pace while watched outside down the back straight, put away the early speed foe in upper stretch, braced for the challenge by the winner outside at the eighth pole, was unwavering to the finish line but was on the losing end of a tight three-way photo for the win. BOLT ENOREE stalked close to the back of the pack between horses, rallied three wide with foes on either side with a quarter mile left to go, posed a threat looming five wide in upper stretch, brushed the winner outside when switching leads at the furlong pole and evened out in deep stretch. STORMS OF LIFE stalked near the rear on the rail, could see the compact field on the fence at the half, kept pace waiting inside around the far bend, shifted four wide at the top of the lane and finished up mildly late passing weary ones in deep stretch.

MORE MONEY HUNNY hounded the pace from the onset, continued to shadow the frontrunner down the backstretch, vied for the lead between horses at the quarter pole, could not quicken with the other leaders in upper stretch and tired by the furlong marker. NANTUCKETS DAY travelled three wide between foes in mid-pack in the beginning, moved up to be in the second flight with rivals on both sides tracking the leaders at the half, held her own when roused just off the fence in midfield around the final bend, had a seam in the two path straightening out for the drive but lacked a rally in the final eighth of a mile. VAZHI settled just behind the engaged pair in the early stages, waited for running room on the fence around the last turn, had a clear path on the rail in upper stretch to be in range for a piece of the prize, had no finish to give by the furlong pole and yielded to others late. SHAMANS GIRL stalked near the rear on the outside three wide, made little movement four deep along the backside, travelled four wide around foes but was giving way by the quarter pole on the turn and emptied out in the seven path at the top of the lane.

I'M A GAMBLER (IRE) had a nice set up outside watching the front pair, closed in on the turn to press the issue three wide at the quarter pole, gathered more speed six wide straightening out for home and pulled away smartly for the win in the final furlong. RAPID TEST stalked three deep on the outside ahead of a few runners down the back straight, made little headway around the bend, was asked for more at the quarter pole with little response, kept on coming gradually down the lane on the wrong lead, switched to the proper lead at the sixteenth pole finding another gear late and got up right at the wire to best the rest. TWIN CITY was tucked in on the fence watching the top two runners, had to be geared down waiting on the rail for the cue to move in midturn. rallied up the fence down the stretch to poke his head in front for the runners up share with a sixteenth left to run but could not hold for the secondary

placing at the wire. IRONSTONE broke a step slow to be near the rear on the outside of rival down the backside, did not start a rally until shifting out off tiring foes seven wide in mid-stretch and when clear uncorked a sharp run late gaining on runners with every stride but ran out of ground to be on the losing end of a three way photo for the runners up share. SECRET RESERVE travelled in mid-division in the two path, kept pace with rival three wide around the bend, sat just behind the dueling leaders in the two path in upper stretch, shifted to be four wide in mid-stretch and finished mildly in the late stages of the race. RONDURE was allowed to settle into stride at the back of the pack in the early going, saved ground narrowing the margin on the leaders through the turn, angled just off the fence in the two path for the drive but had little presence in the stretch running.

PRINCE OF THIEVES was under snug hold on the rail watching the front two in the early going, edged closer on the fence down the backside, moved to the leader sharply when roused at the quarter pole outside, dueled outside on the wrong lead down the stretch, pulled away when getting to the proper lead at the sixteenth pole and held safe from the late closing rival at the finish line. ZIPPY GIZMO was unhurried trailing in the beginning, started to make a move bursting between foes three furlongs from the wire, shifted outside horses continuing to circle four wide at the quarter pole, was full of run in the six-path straightening out for the drive and was closing in smartly late but could not get to the winner in time. GHOSTLY SPITFIRE travelled on the rail in mid-division, was checked entering the backstretch to be shuffled back a few positions, was urged three furlongs out making little impression on the fence, shifted out to be three wide finding another gear late and was full of run in the last furlong to close in and capture the show award. STORMIN DAVE tracked the pacesetter just outside in the beginning, took closer order down the backside, quickly swept past for the lead at the three furlong pole, battled inside with the winner down the lane but faded in deep stretch to settle on the fringes. LIL BIT GANGSTA settled near the rear in second last, could not improve down the backside to be at the rear seeing the field three eighths from home, shifted out three wide picking up the bit, angled to the five-path finding his best stride late and passed many foes in deep stretch. PATROLMAN was bumped outside on the start, had to checked briefly coming to the three quarters pole, stalked in the second to last flight between foes down the backside, was roused three wide on the final bend offering a mild response and finished up one paced in the five path in the stretch drive. WINSTON BLUE was forwardly placed early keeping a close eye on the top three, was nudged but could not maintain position inside runners at the half, made little headway of the rail around the last turn and finished up gradually passing some down the stretch. GREEN AMAZON was jostled between horses on the break, stalked near the back of the pack in the first turn ahead of a few runners, improved three deep outside foes along the backside, continued to rally following the winner in the last turn, dueled in the four path in mid-stretch for the show money, could not find more late though and weakened between horses in the last sixteenth of a mile. SILVER SMOKE broke in on the start, was loose on the lead into the first bend, rolled along unopposed up top but did slow the tempo down the backside, lost the lead on the rail with three eighths to go, gave way to the front two runners around the final bend and backed up through the field shortening stride on the fence at the furlong marker. SAMMY STONE travelled in midfield outs in the initial turn, had runners on either side still in the middle of the pack along the back straight, came under a ride but was going the wrong way midway on the second turn and retreated between rivals four wide in upper stretch. FLAWLESS RULER stalked three wide ahead of a couple of horses into the first turn, made little advancement three deep down the backside, lost ground to others four wide through the last turn, was eased in the seven path turning for home and left via equine ambulance.
