STOLEN co-trailed on the fence in the early going, edged up inside foes by the half, lengthened stride gaining on the leaders in midturn, shifted out three wide at the guarter pole, had a full head of steam in the four path at the top of the stretch and wore down the inside rivals at the sixteenth pole for the win. GALLEY HEAD was away alertly to be on top at the start, hounded the pacesetter down the backside, continue to press the leader outside throughout the turn, battled on stubbornly between runners on the wrong lead down the lane in the three path but was not match late for the winner outside who had just a little bit more late. MORAL TURPITUDE hopped on the break, then had to checked coming up to runners on the fence entering the first turn, trailed the field down the backside and passed a tiring early in upper stretch. ROOKIE COURT assumed the lead on the rail setting a tepid pack in the early stages, was collared outside at the three furlong marker, offered no resistance, backed away through the field on the final turn and was eased when crossing the finish line.

JUST A GEM was off a step slow to begin, stalked on the outside in the third flight, dropped back at the half ahead of only the troubled starter, had a sharp turn of foot swooping four wide around foes at the quarter pole, swung out gathering more speed six wide turning for home and flew past the leader at the furlong pole, going away convincingly at the wire. GOODNIGHT MY ANGEL was under a tight hold sitting behind the pacesetter on the rail, shifted out to track the leader outside down the back straight, assumed the front between foes with five sixteenths from home, spurted away in upper stretch but had no answer when the winner stormed past at the eight [pole and held on for the secondary share in the end. BEAUTIFUL SKY broke out exchanging bumps with outside rival, stalked in the third flight inside, had to be checked in tight quarters just when starting to make a move two furlongs out losing all momentum, shifted out four wide for clear run in early stretch and closed with a rush to capture third money and threaten for the runners up share in the process as well. MIA MITOLE travelled four wide on the outside in mid-pack around the initial turn, moved in to force the issue three wide on the final bend, was still in the hunt four wide at the top of the stretch, could not go with the lead pair by the furlong marker, dueled outside for third place but was caught by a surging outside foe late. VRANA (IRE) broke in bumping inside foe on the start, tracked between in the early going, was shuffled back a spot or two at the seven sixteenths pole, resurged with a quarter mile to run, battled inside for the show money down the lane but tired in deep stretch. HUMBLE HEART leapt up/tossing her head at the start, was checked inside coming under the wire for the first time rushing up on a fellow rival, had to be checked again angling out midway through the first turn, trailed the field down the backside, angled to the seven path for the stretch run and passed a straggler in mid-stretch.

FROGINAPOND took this field into the first turn in the two path, dictated terms unchallenged down the backside, was hard ridden but relinquished midway
around the final bend, had nothing left to offer by the quarter pole and folded on the fence by the furlong marker.

LOADED JUSTICE had a nice trip tucked in on the fence behind the frontrunner, waited on the turn behind the embattled pair, shifted out three wide off the dueling leaders in mid-stretch, seized command by the sixteenth pole and had just enough left in reserve to fend off the late outside challenger at the wire. RED IN FRONT settled on the fence watching the front three, shifted outside midway along the backside, took closer order to track the contesting pair outside into the turn, moved in to bid three wide by the quarter pole, shifted out four wide in the thick of things straightening out for home, fought on gamely outside but could not get past the stubborn winner down the stretch. HANLAN had a slim lead between horses down the backside, maintained a narrow advantage on the fence around the turn, battled on the rail in upper stretch, put away the pesky early speed foe by the eighth pole but was no match for the top two finishers who closed in strongly in deep stretch and settled for a clear third at the finish. ASHUKA prompted the pace three deep, continued to hound the frontrunner outside throughout the turn, dueled stubbornly in the two path in upper stretch but gave way by the furlong marker staying on to be a fringe player in the end. CLIVE CROSS travelled on the rail in midfield, was roused on the fence closing the gap smartly by the half mile marker, moved up in the two path around the turn, shifted out five wide at the top of the lane and finished up willingly gaining on the leaders late. HALCON NEGRO broke out on the start, travelled in the rail in midfield, started to rally splitting runners midturn to have a chance for a piece of the prize behind the front four in mid-stretch but could only finish up evenly late posing no threat. STEPHEN B GOOD was situated in the middle of the pack four deep, made no headway four wide around the turn, swung out widest in the seven path for the drive but had little presence in the stretch drive outside foes. MAMBO BLUE stalked near the rear at the start, made an early move rushing up along the backside, tracked the top three between by the half, kept pace under a ride three wide around the bend, angled six wide for the stretch run and finished up gradually down the lane. FAST FRIENDS was brushed inside on the break, stalked near the rear four deep outside rivals along the backside, made little progression travelling three wide on the turn and could not factor in the stretch running. JAVA POWER stalked close to the back of the pack ahead of only the poor starter down the backside, made no movement taking the short way around the turn, angled out to the two path turning for home and passed a rival in upper stretch. GLORIOUS REVENGE hopped on the break, settled in midfield in the beginning, stalked in the third flight on the inside of rivals down the backstretch, regressed on the fence through the turn and emptied out on the rail by the top of the stretch. ONE HELL OF A GIRL hesitated then veered inwards on the break, trailed down the backstretch, lost touch with the field around the bend and galloped down the stretch crossing the finish line.
