CONACHER had the rail position in mid-pack, edged up on the front twosome taking the shortest route on the the turn, hugged the rail coming with a run in upper stretch, shifted outside off the tiring leader at the eighth pole and drove by in deep stretch, drawing away for the win in the final seventy yards with a good late kick. COME ON BIG LOU shook loose from the pack on the rail for a clear lead by the half, rolled along unchallenged throughout the turn, was still well in command just off the fence straightening out for home, was roused inside the furlong pole but was getting a little weary, offered little resistance to the winner going by on the outside in deep stretch and comfortably held at the finish line to best the rest for the runners up share. VERY DEBONAIRE was allowed to settle into stride down the back straight trailing the field at the half, started to get into gear on the turn picking up an inside rival at the quarter pole, swung out widest gathering momentum in the five path turning for home and closed in belatedly to be a non threatening third outside of horses at the finish line. CHUNKY MONKEY settled between foes in the three path in mid-division in the early going, kept pace through the bend still having rivals on both sides around the turn and finished up willingly in the two path in the stretch drive, just getting up on the inside at the wire winning the battle for the minors. LEMON TWIST tracked the frontrunner on the outside down the back straight, pursued the leader in vain around the oval, still remained in the mix three wide for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but faded slightly in the final furlong just yielding to the inside rival for a minor placing in the end. GO JIMMY GO broke sharp for the lead in the beginning, settled four deep outside of runners in midfield with a half mile still to run, travelled three wide outside two rivals making no headway around the oval and lacked a rally in the four path at the top of the stretch. MIAH SAID stalked the pacesetter in the three path with horses on either side along the backside, dropped back through the to see the field on the fence at the quarter pole and could not play a factor in the late running.

LOVE YOU LIPPY got away well and was immediately urged forward and clear, set the pace near the inside, was asked passing the quarter pole, kicked away extending the margin in upper stretch, held sway while kept to task. SOUPERGIRL chased the winner from outside, made no headway in the stretch, was second best. HARD TO CAPTURE settled at the back dropping well off the leader, moved out beginning to advance past the five-sixteenths, fanned seven wide, was along for show. SOUPER SUNDAY came in at the break, chased from outside rivals, lost third late. OL' BLONDIE was in a bit tight at the start, raced off the pace on or just off the rail, swung five wide turning for home, had mild late interest. PRIMA bobbled slightly at the start, chased first between rivals then inside a foe, weakened in the stretch. TABLOID MATERIAL was outside foes toward the back, ridden along past the three-eighths three

to four wide, failed to rally. CYMBAL COURT was in tight just after the start, chased from between foes and was strongly encouraged three furlongs out, was never close enough to threaten. GARNET AND GOLD chased from inside briefly, dropped back and switched out past the half, chased fanning five to six wide into upper stretch, failed to rally.

HOLIDAY SNOOZE rated kindly having the rail keeping a close eye on the front twosome on the first turn as well as along the backside, mounted a rally when called upon at the five sixteenths pole, moved out full of run two wide in upper stretch, pounced to the lead at the furlong pole and just had enough left late to hold off the oncoming outside charge by the runner up at the finish line for the win. SPRUNG LOOSE co-trailed on the rail initially the beginning, inched up inside of runners with a half mile remaining, started to pick up the bit making a move inside at the quarter pole, shifted out to the three path looking like the main opposition to the eventual winner at the head of the lane and was closing in determinedly in deep stretch but could not get there in time. POLITICAL WARFARE was roused from the outer post right at the start to clear off for the lead on the fence around the first of two turns, slowed the tempo down unopposed down the back straight, moved well up top through the final bend, scraped paint holding on turning for home, was no match for the late charge from the top two finishers outside in the final furlong though, but did finish up well enough to clearly last for the show money at the wire. KING ROSSO was forwardly placed on the rail initially, dropped back in the two path to be part of the rear quartet going around the first turn, made little progression stalking between foes down the backside, came under a ride spinning his wheels at the five sixteenths pole between foes and found his best stride in the two path in stretch drive to win the duel outside, settling on the fringes in the end. LONNY'S GAMBLE travelled four wide sharing the back end with three inside runners around the first turn, trailed just off the fence down the backside, caught up to rivals skimming the fence at the top of the stretch

and showed some late interest on the rail in the final furlong battling for a minor placing inside in the end. CONNOR was under a snug hold contently watching the pacesetter just outside fir the first half of this two turn race, was scrubbed on chasing the leader but to no avail around the last bend, could not continue on in the stretch run and folded in the four path by mid-stretch. THOR'S CAUSE travelled in the three path at the back, made no movement three deep outside horses down the backstretch, was urged on for more run offering little response three wide outside runners on the last turn and failed to menace in the four path outside horses through the lane. YORKTON'S HONOUR had a good spot on the outside of another tracking the lead front pair in the early stages, was roused for more run but was going in the wrong direction on the last bend when three wide outside rivals at the quarter pole and had little left for the drive, tiring between horses three wide at the top of the lane.

TIGER TOWN had a good position on the fence drafting behind the frontrunner, sat poised in mid-pack just off the fence in the running around the bend, skimmed the rail taking closer order turning for home, weaved through rivals shifting to the two path leaving the furlong pole and exploded between horses in the final sixteenth of a mile to draw away for the late running win. CAPTIVATING NAME settled three deep close to the back of the pack down the backstretch, ranged up trying to circle foes three to four wide around horses through the turn, shifted to the six path having a good late rally outside rivals midway down the lane and finished up strongly to be second best behind the winner. RIDE FOR THE PURSE was unhurried down the backside to trail this field at the half, shared the rear inside two others early through the turn, shifted out at the quarter pole starting to reach for more ground, angled to the five

path looking for running room at the top of the stretch, was stymied at the furlong pole losing his lane, switched out seven wide at the sixteenth pole and charging home late to get up at the finish line to be a troubled third in the end. ALPHA KADIN had the three path between foes tracking the leader down the backside, moved in three wide around the turn to force the issue outside at the quarter marker, was in the thick of things three wide in upper stretch, evened out drifting outside slightly in the late running and was nabbed for the show money in the final few jumps. DRAKE DRIVE assumed command on the fence soon after the start, rolled along on the turn having company on the outside by the quarter pole, spurted away briefly on fence in upper stretch, still was clinging onto the lead inside while shortening stride never switching leads down the lane and wilted on the fence in the final seventy yards. KNOWING stalked near the rear in the two path, was checked three wide between runners at the three furlong pole losing its run to be at the back of the pack by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the seven path for the stretch drive, closed in smartly outside rivals late but could not get into contention at the finish line. STIRLING CASTLE travelled four deep in midfield down the back straight, kept pace outside two others while three wide around the bend, had a chance dueling between rivals in the four path in mid-stretch, lost its path with an inside rival drifting outside at the sixteenth pole losing his momentum and was wrapped up in deep stretch. PIN BOY popped up and outwards hitting the gate on the break to see the field after the start, improved along the backside between foes to sit in midfield in the two path by the half, waited for the cue to go looking for a seam running two wide though the turn, had a chance for a small share but was in tight in the three path between horses in upper stretch and failed to fire with the group clustered in the final eighth of a mile. YODDHA chased the pace outside early on, could not keep up to the lead duo on the turn by the quarter pole, had little to offer in the stretch drive and was engulfed by runners on either side at the furlong marker.

GREY PRINCESS had the fence while stalking close to the back of the pace, could not improve position but moved closer along the backside, made a sharp move quickening inside horses at the five sixteenths pole, angled out to loom five wide between foes in upper stretch, stated on tge incorrect lead through the lane but nevertheless got the better of the boys outside in deep stretch to inch away for the victory in the shadow of the wire. TIZ ROMANTIC had the rail while sitting in midfield, narrowed the margin on the frontrunner inside of two others on the rail by the half, took up the chase closing in midway around the last turn, shifted outside coming on at the quarter pole to be a threatening presence between runners three wide in upper stretch, was gaining gradually on the pacesetter in the late running but was slightly outkicked by the winner outside in the final few strides in a photo finish for the win. MAD DOG N JOE was on a mission, hustled with intent on the lead from the outer post to be clear up top on the fence around the first turn, had an uncontested advantage down the backside, continued up top but rivals were getting closer throughout the far turn, still was stubbornly holding on in the two path finding

more in the lane by the eighth pole but could not fend off rivals late and gave way grudgingly on the inside losing the three way tight finish for the win. LOBBY BAR stalked three wide near the rear on the first turn, made little headway in the three path down the back straight, had a mild turn of foot advancing four wide around foes at the five sixteenths pole to be in with a chance in the five path turning for home, could only finish up one paced through the stretch and settled on the fringes in the end. THREE SONNY SIDEUP was content sitting well back of the loose leader in the early going, began to reel in the pacesetter with runners on each side, tracking at the half, had little offer on the final turn back pedalling in the two path midpoint of the last turn and could not get involved on the fence in the late running. LIL BIT GANGSTA broke a step slow to see this field in the early stages, still lagged behind around the far turn, had little to show for the drive and could only manage to pass an inside weary runner while four wide at the furlong marker. MEDIA SENSATION settled in midfield just off the rail, took closer order tracking the leader three deep outside two others at the half, was scrubbed in for more but regressed between rivals at the five sixteenths pole and emptied of in the two path by mid-stretch.

AMI'S CRY was checked slightly on the fence forcing the pace into the backstretch, emerged with a clear lead inside by tge half, opened up on the next closest pursuer through the turn, had command on the rail in upper stretch, was fading up front asking for the wire in the late stages and just lasted at the finish line for the win. THAT'S A FACT was ahead of only the slow starter along the backside, shifted out off the rail beginning to reach for more ground at the quarter pole, angled to the five path finding her best stride late and rallied smartly in deep stretch to almost get to the leg weary winner at the wire. STRAWBERRY WORLD had the rail position in the middle of the pack, kept pace on the fence, saving all the ground around the bend, scraped painting taking closer order at the top of the stretch and ran on willingly to capture the show money at the finish line. MALIBU BETTY travelled close to the back while four deep outside of rivals down the backside, was urged along three wide outside foes on tge turn starting to uncork a run by the quarter pole, angled

to the five path with horses on either side in upper stretch and finished up mildly, catching an inside fading runner late to be a fringe player in the end. SHE'S SO CROATIAN had her head in front briefly in the beginning, tracked the leader on the outside at the half, chased but the winner was getting away around the turn, moved to the three path for the drive, evened out by the furlong marker and was wrapped up on when crossing the finish line. SWEET VALENTINE had an outside position in the second flight along the backside watching the lead duo, held her own staying in range of the front pair around the turn, dueled for a minor role four wide at the top of the stretch but weakened inside of runners in the final sixteenth of a mile. UNCARRICK TERISTIC stalked near the rear in the three path early on, made no progression going three wide around tge turn outside foes , swung out widest to the six path for the drive to the wire but had no impact outside horses in the late running. TANZANITE LILY travelled in the two path between foes in midfield, was asked for more run at the five sixteenths pole offering little response around the oval and had no finishing kick to give inside rivals in the two path in the stretch running. STARRIOT was away slowly being a long last down the backside, trailed throughout the turn, lost touch with the pack by upper stretch and cantered home down the lane.
