PICKFORD SWEET settled between rivals stalking the top two into the first of two turns, inched closer when coaxed having runners on both sides midway through the last bend, was roused three wide straightening out for the drive, rider lost his crop coming up the leaders outside in upper stretch, quickly opened up by the furlong marker and coasted in for the dominant win under a hand ride. SERENADING AMAYA travelled three wide outside horses watching the front duo in the early going, could see the compact field three deep down the backstretch, edged closer still having a three wide journey around the far turn, shifted to the four path for the drive but was no competition for the powerful stablemate late and easily bested the rest when crossing the finish for the runners up share. NO VISOR was loose on the lead into the first turn, set a soft pace on the fence while pressed outside along the backstretch, maintained a slim lead on the inside of rivals turning for home, could not go with the top two finishers by the furlong pole and finished up willingly to stay on for third money at the wire. HEY NIAMH chased the pace outside around the initial bend, closed in to hound the frontrunner down the back straight, dueled outside through the final turn, vied up front between rivals in the two path at the top of the lane but evened out down the stretch to settle for a minor role. SUPER SHAMAN had a good spot tucked in behind the pacesetter, rated kindly in midfield on the fence along the backside, was nudged for more with five sixteenths to go but could not rally with others making a run and in the two path had little to offer in the stretch running.

COMMANDER AT SEA stalked near the rear on the rail settling into a good rhythm in the beginning, shifted three wide at the quarter pole gathering momentum while still in hand, had a full head of steam in the six path at the top of the stretch, found his best stride late and prevailed in a stretch duel in deep stretch just holding on for the win at the wire. BENLION was unhurried trail down the backside, could see the field by a good margin around the bend, closed the gap sharply by the quarter pole, swung out full of run seven wide at the top of the lane, switched back to the incorrect lead just when coming up to the leaders in deep stretch, still fought on tenaciously late but was denied by a nod at the finish for the win. TREBUCHET tracked the front threesome while outside a runner in the early going, angled out off the leaders at the quarter pole to loom five wide in upper stretch, seized command by the furlong marker but could not fend off the late rivals closing in outside in deep stretch. HEY LUIGI forced the pace inside down the back straight, bobbed heads up top on the fence around the turn, put away the early speed foes in the two path straightening out for home, braced for the closing challengers outside while clinging up top in mid-stretch but faded in the final seventy yards to settle on the fringes in the end. CANADIAN DADDY broke in a tangle hitting the inside of the gate at the start, settled on the rail in midfield along the backside, waited inside a rival behind the embattled trio around the turn, skimmed the fence turning for home to be in the hunt by the furlong pole but needed more late to pose a threat in the final sixteenth. DELIRIO stumbled at the start, recovered to be in a good spot alone watching the engaged pair down the backside in hand, moved in three wide to prompt the issue at the three eighths pole, battled outside around the turn, had little left for the drive and faltered between horses four wide in upper stretch. PROFESORRIDESAGAIN had a narrow lead

outside down the backstretch, vied between rivals up front through the turn, was the first of the lead three to give way at the quarter pole and folded in the three path by the furlong marker.

OUR LADY PEACE was squeezed on the break to travel in midfield along the backside, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole mounting a run, bullied her way through splitting foes in the four path at the sixteenth pole reaching for more ground and got up in the last stride to get the win right at the finish line under a well-timed late surge. FANNY M broke out on the start, battled outside of a stubborn rival throughout the turn, edged away for the clear lead in the two path at the sixteenth pole but could not fend off the late charge by the winner right at the wire. STERLING HEIGHTS dueled inside up front in the early stages, continued to be unyielding on the fence in upper stretch but gave way grudgingly in the late stages still holding for the show award at the finish line. WEGOTTATALK sat just off the top pair outside down the backstretch, ranged up three wide by the quarter pole to be in the mix in the three path between

foes at the top of the lane but could not continue the stretch rally and finished up one paced in the late stages for a minor role. SCARY BOO was roused from the start getting a better forward position angling in down the backside to sit tracking the lead trio while three deep at the half, kept pace while scrubbed on three wide through the turn, was in with a chance four wide at the top of the lane but weakened in the final sixteenth of a mile. CANTUCCINI was checked leaving the chute, co trailed on the inside down the back straight, took closer order to the field by the quarter pole and finished with good late energy gaining on runners in deep stretch. PRIZED SPIRIT broke in on the break, stalked in the third flight between horses down the backside, took closer order around the turn to sit just behind the dueling leaders two wide turning for home, rider lost his crop in upper stretch and under a vigorous hand ride down the lane fought on until giving way in the late stretch at the sixteenth pole. BAYTOWN STORM broke a step slow to begin, was then nudged trying to get a better inside position, improved on the fence down the backside to track the top three on the rail by the half, was hard ridden trying to match strides while inside runners on the turn and wilted on the fence by mid-stretch. BLACK GODDESS was checked early on entering the backstretch to co-trail on the outside, made no progression at the rear throughout the turn and could only manage to pass a weary foe down the stretch. NO MALARKEY was steadied sharply at the eleven sixteenths pole to stalk near the rear outside along the backstretch, made no headway three wide around the bend, shifted out to the four path in upper stretch and was not persevered with down the lane galloping across the finish line in the end.

MOTOWN FUNK broke inwardly and steadied, advanced between runners two to three wide into and on the turn chasing mid-pack in behind the leaders, came out four to five wide in the stretch, gained place late. RELOAD EH was bumped at the start then coaxed to the lead to set the pace from just off the rail and shadowed by the eventual winner, moved clear coming to the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. SERIOUS GREEN bumped a rival at the start, settled at the back, was two wide on the turn, finished with mild late interest up the inside. HER OBSESSION raced outside at the back, swung seven wide turning for home, passed foes. MIGHT BEE SPECIAL broke sharply but was soon overtaken, stalked from outside racing mostly four to six wide, failed to menace. PERFECTLY RED saved ground but failed to threaten. IMPERIAL TRICK hit the gate and was forced in at the start, chased from between runners mid-pack, was three to four wide through the turn and faded in the stretch.

HOME FOR A REST had a tracking role between horses down the backside, continued outside measuring the leader around the turn, took closer order starting to lengthen stride four wide turning for home, swept on past under confident handling at the sixteenth pole and was going away for the win at the wire. LOOKS LUCKY TO ME was in hand pressing on the inside in the early going, poked her head in front briefly entering the turn, was relegated again to a chasing role on the fence with five sixteenths to go unable to match strides with the front runner on the turn, still was in the hunt for a share in the two path between rivals at the furlong marker, could not go with the winner late but with a solid late effort rebid to come back on for the place share in the final seventy yards. I'M A BOURBON GIRL settled on the fence in the second flight, kept pace while on the rail throughout the turn, shifted out to the four path and closed belatedly down the stretch to get up for the show award just before the finish line. VICTORIA ELIZABETH assumed command outside down the backstretch, edged away from the early speed foe midway through the turn, was collared outside by the winner just inside the eighth pole, had little left late and faded in deep stretch unable to hold for third money in the last few strides. FAITHFUL CREEK was allowed to settle at the rear down the backside, began to pick up horses midway around the bend, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch run but could only finish up gradually to the wire making little presence late. I'M TENACIOUS was under a tight hold four deep ahead of only one runner down the back straight, trailed the field with five sixteenths remaining and could only manage to pass a weary runner in deep stretch. CARDIO PRINCESS (JPN) stumbled on the break, tracked three deep on the outside in the beginning, dropped back a touch at the half, made little impression around the bend and angled five wide for the drive but failed to menace in

the stretch run between horses.

DELPHIA took control right from the onset, was loose up top unopposed around the bend, opened up at will at the furlong marker and pulled away even more for the frontrunning score when crossing the finish line. DREAMING OF AUDREY tracked three deep on the outside early on, moved closer to chase the pacesetter through the turn and stubbornly kept trying to get to the winner but to no avail in the lane settling for a clear but distant second best at the wire. TAYLORMOON co-trailed three deep at the half, rallied three wide around runners at the three furlong pole, had a chance for a piece of the prize in the four path at the top of the lane and in the two path in the final sixteenth determinedly just held on for the show award between rivals when crossing the line. ALBERTA BE MINE tracked the leaders with runners on either side down the backstretch, was shuffled back a couple of positions in midturn, shifted out off rivals four wide at the eighth pole and was gaining late for third money but had to settle for a minor placing in the end. PLUIE D'AVRIL was in tight trailing after the start, began to pick up foes inside with three furlongs from home, shaved the rail at the top of the lane, dueled for the show award in mid-stretch but evened out in the final seventy yards losing that battle. SEATTLE CAUSEWAY travelled in midfield on the fence improved up the rail by the half mile

marker, sat just behind tracking the pacesetter through the turn, was encouraged right hand turning for home, offered little response and faltered while not switching lead down the stretch. COLOR FORCE co-trailed between horses at the half, could see the field at the three eighths pole, regressed around the turn and had little to offer in the stretch running.

CRIMSON NIGHTS broke sharp, was patiently reined in sitting behind the contesting duo down the backstretch, waited to pounce moving smoothly outside a runner three wide around the turn, loomed a menacing presence five wide at the top of the lane, battled neck and neck outside with a furlong from the line and had a little more left late, outkicking the inside rival to inch away for the win in deep stretch. THIRSTY ACCOUNTANT dueled outside at the start, sat outside just off the pacesetter by the half, inched up in the turn to take command outside at the quarter pole, fought on stubbornly between horses clinging onto the lead with a furlong left to run but could not find another gear late to repel the relentless winner in final seventy yards. SHAMELESS AFFAIR was away alertly on the break, then took back to sit in mid-pack all alone in the three path along the backside, edged up behind the front trio at the quarter pole, angled out six wide for the drive to the wire and closed in well down the stretch not switching leads to be a clear third at the finish line. ONDINE LADY

travelled on the rail in mid-division, advanced on the turn sitting behind the leaders at the quarter pole, darted from the three path to the rail in mid-stretch and got the nod for the minors winning that duel in the final seventy yards. SECRET BUTTERFLY was hustled after the start to get a clear lead on the rail by the half, had company outside by the quarter pole, fought on in the two path until the furlong marker and faded in the final sixteenth. MOET MONET broke out and had to be checked soon after the start, stalked near the rear on the fence, saved ground through the turn keeping pace but lacked a rally inside horses down the stretch. TALKING WONDERS was well back in the last flight midway along the backstretch three deep, moved up three wide making a brief run at the three furlong pole to be in range if good enough widest in the seven path for a share straightening for the drive, could not sustain the rally though and flattened out in the final furlong. BEAUMONT DRIVE was unhurried trailing down the backside, made no impact going three wide around the bend and could not factor while six wide in the stretch running.
