PARADISE PERFECT broke a step slow patiently trailing the field down the back straight, started to mount a rally shifting off the fence to be four wide getting into gear outside foes at the quarter pole, swung out widest for clear run in the six path at the top of the lane, was in full flight on the outside closing in smartly with a furlong to go, stayed on the incorrect lead to the wire but nevertheless still edged clear for the win in the final seventy yards. SPEEDY CONNECTION traded brushes with the outside runner on the start, recovered quickly to have a slim lead inside another down the backstretch, continued up top narrowly on the fence while hounded by two outside rivals around the oval, spurted away briefly when hugging the rail turning for home and stubbornly gave way inside to the winner in deep stretch. YOU AND ME BABY travelled three deep tracking the engaged pair down the backside, ranged up three wide under a busy ride outside the leader around the bend, angled to the four path never wavering between foes to the wire and ran on willingly in the final furlong to be a clear third at the finish line. PREF settled between horses in the middle of the pack, kept pace having challengers on either side through the turn, skimmed the fence in upper stretch passing tired runners inside at the furlong pole and finished up with interest to garner a minor award in the end. GUS'S DRUMBEET forced the pace on the outside early on, was scrubbed on chasing the frontrunner in vain between rivals throughout the turn, had little left for the stretch running and yielded three wide between runners at the furlong marker. PRINCE ALMASTY brushed the inside rival on the break, settled on the rail in mid-division along the back straight, had little movement with runners on either side around the bend and could not offer a finish in the stretch drive, yielding in the two path between horses in the final furlong.

SUNRISE DRIVE rated kindly on the outside in the second flight watching the contesting duo, began to pick up the bit when called upon three wide outside foes at the three furlong pole closing in around the last turn, moved in four wide taking control at the top of the stretch and while on the wrong lead still

cruised in easily for the win at the wire. MEHLEK was unhurried at the rear going three wide on the first bend, lagged behind the group down the backside, had to take the overland route four wide around horses at the five sixteenths starting to reach for more ground, was looking for a seam four wide in upper stretch in tight for a brief moment, got a clear lane in the three path by the furlong pole, could not get to the long gone winner in the late running but did fight on determinedly inside to get the runners up share right at the wire. FAST AND READY stalked near the rear on the inside in the early stages, was relegated to last having no room to extend his stride at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out to the seven path reaching for more ground and had good late energy on the outside of another almost getting the nod for the second-place share at the finish line. BET N WIN travelled three wide on the first of two turns close to the back end, improved three deep outside of horses along the backside, edged up going three to four wide around runners on the final turn, was in the mix angling out six wide straightening out for home and ran on mildly to the wire garnering a minor share in the end. MISTER MESEEKS had a good spot initially nestled on the fence keeping a close eye on the lead duo, was poised inside waiting for running room on the far turn, had nowhere to go stuck behind the fading early leaders at the quarter pole with the outside rivals making a rally, scraped paint finally getting a clear lane in upper stretch but failed to fire in the last eighth of a mile. KIDDIE HOLIDAY stalked close to the back of the pack in the two path between horses, made a brief run around rivals three wide at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest in the eight path in with a chance for a small share but could not continue the rally and evened out in the final furlong. GUILDSMAN (FR) had the inside position in the middle of the pack, offered little movement down the backside, was hard held lacking running room midway on the far turn and could not get involved two wide in the stretch running. SILENT FORTUNE had a slim lead on the inside just off the rail early on, continued up front having a narrow advantage setting a brisk but even tempo inside down the back straight, dueled on the fence clinging onto the lead on the far turn by the quarter pole, had nothing left in reserved at the top of the lane and was engulfed by runners on each side, emptying out by the furlong marker. MO TOURIST settled in midfield outside another rival in midfield, was roused in the far turn taking closer order but in tight surroundings when the field was bunching up at the quarter pole but wilted shifting to the four path in upper stretch. IF YOU INSIST was antsy in the stall prior to the start, breaking slow when the gates opened up, guickly recovered to force the pace three wide on the outside around the first turn, continued to hound the leader outside down the backside, battled outside early on the final turn, gave way up top in the three path drifting outwards in upper stretch, had nothing left for the drive and folded by the furlong marker.

LEGAL CATCH was caught three to four wide in the early going, chased from mid-pack up the backstretch then dropped back.

ELLA IT IS broke inwards on the start, had a good spot tucked in on the rail watching the contesting duo throughout, patiently waited for running room on the face behind the lead pair with a quarter mile to run, moved out in the two path splitting horses in upper stretch and drove past sharply reaching for more ground impressively in the final sixteenth of a mile to win going away at the wire. HINT was under a snug hold having the lead on the rail in the first turn, set a modest pace while hounded outside down the back straight, continued to keep her head in front while battling with the outside rivals through the last bend, edged away for a clear advantage hugging the rail turning for home but could not match strides in deep stretch with the winner outside who had an ideal setup throughout the race. PEACE POSEY broke outwards on the start, stalked in the two path close to the back of the pack, travelled in the third tier outside another down the backside, started to edge up three wide around horses at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch run and closed in belatedly to be a distant third at the finish line. JUICY HANNA was bumped inside on the start to be well back of the field early on, still lagged behind the pack down the backstretch, was urged with a left-handed crop commencing a run on the fence at the quarter pole and had a good late rail rally down the lane to get up for a minor placing in the end. KEKOA rated in behind near the rail, made a swift move between foes near the half to take closer order then another rapid move between foes nearing the five-sixteenths taking a narrow lead soon after that marker, vied inside a foe then shook clear of that one turning for home, was challenged in late stretch by an outside rival but gamely held that one to prevail. CIUNAS broke outwardly, settled outside at the rear, was three to five wide throughout advancing outside foes on the far turn, gained steadily in the stretch, just missed. BACHELOR PAD was brushed by the inside foe on the start, still got away alertly to have the clear lead on the fence from the outer post by the five eighths pole, rambled on unchallenged setting a lively pace on the turn and kept finding more just off the fence in the stretch drive to hold comfortably at the finish line for the gate to wire score. ASK IN MY NAME was in the latter part of mid-pack early on with the field spread out by the half, made no headway on the fence in the turn, had a sharp turn of foot cornering on the rail at the top of the stretch and made a strong late charge inside horses in the final furlong to be a solid second best at the finish line. WARLORD CRUZAN travelled three deep watching the leader early on, inched up three wide starting to reel in the pacesetter on the turn, loomed the only threat three wide in upper stretch, was no match for the winner by the eighth pole and finished up willingly late lasting for the show money at the wire. BREAK THE SPELL stalked near the rear three deep outside runners, had a good rally four wide around foes at the three furlong pole circling through the turn to be six wide in upper stretch, could not sustain the run to threaten the front three down the lane but still fought on between horses to settle on the fringes in the end in a tight finish. UNCAPTURED MOMENT was nestled on the rail keeping a close eye on the front threesome, regressed slightly in midturn, still had a chance for a small share three wide in the lane but lost the battle for a minor placing inside at the wire. STONKS was unhurried at the rear down the backside, started to pick up runners outside at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest in the eight path at the head of the lane and finished up with good late energy outside part of the trio dueling for the minors in the end. EL ALACRAN had an inside tracking role down the back straight, chased the winner but was making little gain around the turn and weakened in the two path with horses on either side by mid-stretch. CHAIRMAN BOB settled close to the back in the two path, made little impression outside another around the oval, moved out to the six path turning for home but could not play a factor in the late drive. WALTER ME LAD was part of the second trio of runners between foes in the two path down the back straight, ran on evenly holding position around the bend, shifted to the four path at the top of the lane but yielded to others at the furlong pole. JAMIESTA stalked ahead of only one runner in the beginning, was relegated to the rear midway on the turn having the fence, angled to the two path for the drive to wire and passed weary rivals through the lane. MASTER SPY had the fence in mid-division, was scrubbed on keeping pace with challengers at the three-furlong marker while inside horses throughout the turn, shifted out four wide straightening for home but offered no finishing kick in the late running. DESIGNATED HITTER was forced out by the inside rival on the break, was forwardly placed three deep at the half, crept closer to the lead trio under a vigorous ride in the three path around the turn with a quarter mile remaining, could not find more in the late running though and folded by the furlong marker. QUIET INTENT broke outwards on the start, settled in midfield down the backstretch, was hard ridden at the three-furlong pole but was going the wrong way on the turn by the quarter marker and emptied out in the five path at the top of the stretch.

MYSTIC SONG had the rail sitting in midfield along the backside, moved up on the fence tracking in the second flight poised to make a move through the turn, hugged the rail mounting a rally in upper stretch, powered past taking control by the sixteenth pole inside and edged away for the win at the finish line. SAUCY NAME broke sharp for the early advantage on the inside, narrowly remained up top battling on the fence around the bend, shifted to the three path just holding on with runners bearing down on either side at the furlong pole, drifted out under left-handed encouragement with a sixteenth of a mile still to

run giving way to the winner inside and finished up well enough to be second best crossing the wire. MIGHT BEE TROUBLE travelled three deep on the outside of runners in the back group, started to make a rally around horses three wide midway on the turn, angled out for clear run six wide at the top of the stretch, found his best stride late and closed in to get up in the final jump outside for the show award. WILDFIRE was under a good hold shadowing the frontrunner outside, moved in to battle outside the pacesetter throughout the turn, still was in the thick of things four wide at the top of the stretch up top, was bumped by the inside leader dueling for the front end at the sixteenth pole losing his momentum, tried to get back into gear late but was nabbed outside the wire for the show money. PRINCESSONAMISSION co-trailed on the fence down the backstretch, took the short way around making improvement inside of runners through the turn, scraped paint at the top of the lane and finished in with mild interest on the inside in the late running. UNHEARD travelled between rivals in mid-division, dropped back slightly to be in the third tier still between foes around the oval, moved to the three path for the drive to the wire but could not get into contention, failing to fire in the final furlong. ZIPPY GAMBLE was part of the back trio stalking between runners, could not keep up to others making a run seeing the field around the turn, shifted out to the five path for the stretch drive and could only catch a weary rival inside at the furlong pole. WORLD SHOWCASE tracked the engaged duo while three deep outside runners down the backside, travelled outside the eventual winner in the second flight keeping an eye on the embattled pair through the turn, had little to give turning for home and folded in the four path by upper stretch.
