LEGALLY CHARITABLE was bumped outside on the break, travelled in midfield between foes in the three path down the back straight, edged up to be in the second flight outside around the turn, loomed boldly in the five path at the top of the stretch, powered past for the lead leaving the eighth pole and won going away when crossing the finish line. THATSITTHATSALL was unhurried trailing at the start, started to rally splitting foes three furlongs from the line, swung out to the six path gathering more momentum in early stretch and with a solid late run closed in to best the rest for the runners up share at the wire. SIGIRIYA was content to track outside along the backstretch, took closer order to battle outside by the three eighths pole, dueled through the turn, edged away for a brief lead straightening out for home, had no answer when the winner swept past at the furlong pole and faded a touch late, unable to save the runners up share in deep stretch. SMILES FOR DAVID stalked three deep near the rear, made little headway three wide around foes in the bend, swung out widest in the seven path at the top of the lane and passed some runners late in deep stretch. WAR'S END KISS co-trailed on the inside at the half, made no progression seeing the field through the turn, shifted to the four path for the

FRANK'S ART was coaxed from the start taking this field into the turn, continued setting a brisk pace up top along the backside, repelled the brief challenge by an outside foe with three eighths remaining, opened up at the quarter pole and cruised in for the frontrunning score. DESOLATOR stalked outside close

to the back of the pack, had a quick turn of foot splitting foes midway through the last turn, shifted out three wide at the eighth pole and battled outside to the wire to just win the nod for the secondary share in a photo. BET N WIN broke outwardly, was caught five wide in the early going racing outside foes mid-pack, advanced on the far turn shifting in a bit early on that bend moving three to four wide, had aim in the stretch, ground on steadily to bid between runners late and just get the nod. CLASSY WHISPER tracked in behind off the rail, moved forward between runners early up the backstretch, pressed the issue entering the far turn, took a narrow lead at the top of the stretch, had to keep fighting dueling outside the prior leader, kept that one behind but was just nailed. PRIDEOFDISTINCTION settled outside at the back four to five wide, advanced circling outside foes seven deep late on the far turn, was gaining steadily late but missed. SUGAR IT'S ELI broke outwardly bumping a rival lightly, moved outside to the lead about the seven-eighths, set the pace near the inside facing intermittent prompting from outside foes up the backstretch, was challenged through the far turn and headed by the top of the stretch, fought on gamely late but was ultimately denied. GOOD SIN stalked near the rear on the fence, made a sharp move outside a runner midway around the far turn, circled six wide outside foes turning for home, had his best stride late closing on the leaders down the lane, drifted in under right handed encouragement taking over in the three path at the sixteenth pole and won going away at the finish line. CATHOLIC JACKIE had an inside tracking role into the first turn, watch the front two runners while

nestled on the fence down the back straight, waited for the cue to go sitting behind the frontrunner around the final bend, moved in to bid for the lead on the fence at the furlong marker, could not go with the winner in deep stretch but did find more late to save for second money in a tight finish for that placing. SEATTLE STINGER loped along near the back ahead of only the poor starter, unleashed a strong kick commencing at the five sixteenths pole inside a rival, shifted out gathering more speed at the quarter pole, was full of run in the six path at the top of the lane and finished up smartly to almost get the nod for the runners up share in a photo at the wire. THEFRONTIERSMAN travelled on the rail in mid-pack in the early stages, could not match strides with the outside winner at the quarter pole, kept on coming to be in range of the leaders four wide straightening out for home, had late burst at the seventy-yard pole closing in but a little too late losing the three way photo for the place share and settling on the fringes in the end. BLUE MONTJEU had a stalking role in the third tier on the outside, started to make a move rallying in the four path taking the overland route at the guarter pole, was in the hunt in the four path at the top of the lane and with a strong late charge when urged left handed pulled away for the win in deep stretch. MUCHO MAGNIFICO travelled on the rail in mid-division along the backside, took closer order when roused midway through the last turn, angled five wide having his sights set on the leaders straightening out for the drive, closed in smartly with a sixteenth left to go but had to alter course outside when coming up to the drifting out leader at the sixteenth pole and determinedly fought on to get up for the place share at the wire. SO CALLED VACATION tracked the pacesetter outside in the first of two turns, moved in to prompt the issue outside down the backstretch, dueled outside through the last turn, seized command poking his head in front at the eighth pole, proceeded to drift out under left handed encouragement in the final sixteenth and lost the place share at the wire. VINI VIDI VICI stalked on the rail in the third flight in the early going, moved with the winner on the outside narrowing the margin around the far turn, had to wait stuck behind runners in the two path at the quarter pole, still lacked room in mid-stretch, darted to the fence finding a seam with a sixteenth left to run, did not have enough late when clear to threaten the winner and finished up on the fringes in the end. MIAH SAID was headstrong under a hold three wide into the first turn, watched the engaged pair down the backstretch while tracking on the outside, kept pace with the leaders around last turn to be in range in the three path in upper stretch but could not pose a threat late finishing up one paced in deep stretch. ANNIA CORNIFICIA F travelled on the outside in midfield along the backstretch, closed the gap while under a ride with five sixteenths remaining, swung out to the six path turning for home and finished up gradually outside gaining on some runners late. CONTRIVANCE broke in at the start, set the pace on the fence into the first turn, had company outside forcing the issue down the backside, battled inside neck and neck for the lead through the far turn, had little left for the drive late and was engulfed by runners on both sides in deep stretch. BLONDINA'S BOY settled in the two path ahead of a couple of runners into the initial bend, made no movement along the backside, saved ground throughout the last turn and shifted out off the rail in deep stretch to pass another rival late. ARRAKASTA IZAN made a good move from the outer post getting to the rail to track the front two midway around the first turn, settled inside down the backstretch in the second flight, kept pace travelling on the fence through the far turn, could not find more late and folded on the rail by the sixteenth pole. QUANDALE was slow into stride trailing in the beginning, passed a rival at the seven sixteenths pole outside but could not factor anymore making little presence in the stretch drive. HIGHLAND ROCKY broke with the field, quickly dropped back to be ahead of only one rival into the first turn, was passed by a runner to see the field entering the far turn and could not make any impression in the stretch running.
