MIA MITOLE stalked near the rear on the fence, started to pick up runners three deep at the half, made a strong rally circling foes three wide around the far turn, loomed a menacingly presence in the three path straightening out for home, grinded away on the outside at the furlong pole and just got the better from the determined pacesetter to get the head down right at the line for the victory. KENTUCKY BILL exchanged bumps with the outside rival on the start, settled near the rear with the field tightly compacted at the half, waited behind the embattled trio just off the fence running around the turn, crept closer by the quarter pole, looked for a seam scraping paint straightening out for home, darted through having clear run on the rail in deep stretch and edged clear for the win inside at the wire. PERFECT SPARKLE traded bumps with the inside foe on the break, pressed the issue on the rail down the backstretch, dueled on the fence around the turn, poked her head in front on the inside at the top of the stretch, still was holding on in the two path with challengers bearing down on both sides at the furlong pole, dug in gamely late but could not withstand the late charge by the winner inside in deep stretch. BALBONI'S CREW had her head cocked inwards breaking that way at the start, prompted the pace between horses in the three path down the backside, vied three wide with challengers on either side throughout the turn, still was in the hunt four wide in upper stretch, could not match strides with the top duo by the sixteenth pole but did fight on to hold for the show position at the wire. DEPUTY GHOST was part of the pace scenario on the outside going four deep, was under a ride four wide trying to hold position outside in the lead group around the turn, moved out to the five path in upper stretch still part of the conversation ion the front end turning for home but evened out on the outside in the final sixteenth to settle on the fringes in the end. CATEGORY FIVE stalked at the rear well in range of the leader while outside in the three path early on, tried to circle around the lead quarter five wide around the oval, had no finish to offer in the five path for the drive to the wire but did pick up the leg weary early leader in the final seventy yards. MINIMUM FORTY was away alertly seizing control from the onset, remained up top but only by slim margin with the rider still in the saddle on the fence throughout the turn, was nudged for more two wide at the top of the lane, quickly opened up by the furlong pole, stayed on the incorrect lead to the wire but still increased the winning margin at the finish line. KATHERINE'S CUB travelled three deep keeping a close eye on the frontrunner, kept pace in the second pairing outside through the turn, moved in to be in the hunt in the four path turning for home and chased the winner in vain down the stretch while easily besting the rest for the runners up share at the wire. ALLURING AMY had the rail keeping a close eye on the leader not letting her get away too much early on, chased around the bend making little gain, angled to the three path with aim on the pacesetter at the top of the stretch, was closing in steadily in the final furlong and got up on the outside in the final few strides for the win. DAOU was reluctant to load prior to the start, caught a flyer leaving the gate to be loose up top on the rail from the widest post by the half, moved well uncontested through the turn going comfortably on an easy lead, was still well in command just of the rail at the furlong pole, ran on to the end but could not fend off the winners late charge outside shortly before the wire. MONEY HEIST tracked the frontrunner outside another early on, dropped back slightly in midturn with others rivals making an early move, angled to the five path straightening out for the drive and came back on in mid-stretch to be a clear but distant third. KNOCKONWOOD broke inwards on the start, settled in midfield outside down the backside, gradually was circling around the large field four wide around the oval, swung out widest in the eight path at the top of the lane and finished up willingly to get the nod at the finish line settling on the fringes. SHOOT had a good spot in the three path outside foes watching the top three rivals early on, was roused for more at the five sixteenths pole but could not quicken with rivals on either side by the quarter marker, dropped back six wide in upper stretch and tenaciously re-bid in the final furlong surging at the wire just missing out for a minor placing in a tight photo. LADY DAYRELLS had inside position in the middle of the pack, was scrubbed on for more run at the three eighths marker improving on the fence by the quarter pole, skimmed the fence in with a chance for a share in upper stretch but stalled in the final sixteenth of a mile. SANS DANCER stalked in mid-division between horses at the half, moved in four wide briefly on the turn at the quarter pole, dueled for a minor placing still in the four path cornering for the stretch drive but flattened out with runners on each side with a sixteenth left to run. MYSTICAL MAGIC was bounced around having a rough start to be near the rear on the inside down the back straight, took the short way around the bend narrowing the margin inside with a quarter mile from home, was in the mix for a piece of the prize in the three path at the top of the stretch, could not find more late and yielded between foes at the sixteenth pole. VELOCITA hopped up, then was bumped outside being pushed over on the break, stalked three deep having only one runner beaten down the backstretch, made little headway travelling three wide around the turn, shifted to the four path for the stretch drive but failed to menace in rive to the wire. NO MISTAKE was jostled, being forced in on the break, trailed the field down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, hugged the rail picking up tired runners straightening out for home and hit little to offer in the final furlong. RUBICON MOMENT veered in then was squeezed on the break, settled in the two path close to the back along the backside, made no movement just off the rail around the turn, was relegated to last at the top of the stretch and could not factor in the late running.

BOSSY CANDY tracked from inside, took closer order up the backstretch, moved out nearing the quarter pole, came into upper stretch four wide with aim, was put to urging, took a narrow lead in mid-stretch, edged away late. SOUPER DIVA was quick to take the lead, set the pace from off the rail shadowed by outside foes, moved clear of those runners passing the seven-sixteenths, was challenged at the top of the stretch, fought on gamely inside the winner in mid-stretch but was no match while clearly second best. MATHEMATICAL pursued from outside, went four to five wide on the turn, lugged in a bit in the stretch, was no match for the top pair but clear of the rest. PAGEANT QUEEN settled into stride off the pace and just off the inside, was lightly brushed and in a hair tight in the early going, saved ground on the rail through the turn advancing inside rivals, kept on evenly. FORESTERS EXEC settled in mid-pack four deep on the outside down the back straight, kept pace while going three wide outside of horses around the oval, shifted to the five path for the drive looking for a lane, bullied her way through six wide at the furlong pole and surged late to just get up in time for the gritty win. SINCLAIRITY had the rail while sitting off the embattled pair down the back straight, started to close in shifting out three wide at the quarter pole off the fading leaders, bid for the lead in the four path at the top of the stretch, seized command moving well by the furlong pole but it wasn't enough to fend



off the winners late burst outside right before the wire. JUST FOLLOW ME stalked close to the back having the fence, began to lengthen stride on the rail at the three eighths marker, closed the gap through the turn to be in with a chance two wide looking for a seam at the top of the lane, darted up the looming boldly at the furlong pole but was slightly outkicked in deep stretch for the win but got up for the show money at the finish line. XARABELLA stalked on the outside near the rear, commenced a rally four wide circling around horses at the three-furlong marker, was floated out gathering speed in the seven-path turning for home, determinedly fought on outside rivals to the wire but just missed out in a photo for the third place award. VERDEJO travelled in the three path in midfield between foes, made little headway just off the fence throughout the turn, lacked running room four wide at the head of the lane behind the leaders, had a clear lane in the two path by the furlong pole but failed to fire in deep stretch. MOONLIGHT PROMISES had an outside spot tracking the lead duo, closed in around the turn in the four path with a quarter left to run, angled out five wide in the hunt straightening out for home, could not sustain the rally staying on the incorrect lead and wilted in the final sixteenth of a mile. CANADIANSWEETHEART was void of early foot lagging behind the field down the backside, remained well behind the pack around the turn, shifted to the two path in upper stretch, passed some runners in the lane but could not get into contention in the late stages. I LOVE TO WIN settled between foes in the two path in the middle of the pack, was in tight being shuffled back losing her run at the seven sixteenths pole, shifted to the rail for the stretch drive but lacked a rally down the lane. SOUNDS PRACTICAL was under a busy ride pressing the issue on the fence, dueled on the rail with another while well ahead off the group in midturn, was collared by outside rivals in upper stretch, offered no resistance inside and folded by the furlong marker. GIVE ME THE BOOTS was hustled in the two path having a slim lead early on, battled outside throwing it down separating from the field in midturn up top with another rival inside, was engulfed by outside runners turning for home, had little left for the drive and emptied out in upper stretch.

BENNYS JETS was hustled from the break having the lead on the rail getting a clear advantage by the half, narrowly held on up top inside while hounded by rivals outside throughout the turn, was clinging onto the lead two wide in upper stretch, spurted away briefly on the fence at the furlong pole under right-handed encouragement and was kept to the task right to the end to last at the wire for the gate to wire score. HELLO JELLO was roused at the start while at the back leaving the gate, shifted off the fence coming with a run at the three furlong marker, hugged the rail making his presence felt at the top of the lane, loomed boldly angled off the leader two wide with a furlong still to run and was closing in strongly late but was denied at the finish line. ANOTHER CHARLIE was forwardly placed from the get-go drafting behind the front runner by the seven sixteenths pole, shifted out in the two path in midturn coming

on, bid three wide between horses at the top of the stretch, was no match for the top duo in the final sixteenth but did finish up well enough to clearly hold for the show money. SOUPER STRIDER was unhurried well behind the field down the backside, still remained at the back of the pack around the turn, shifted to the three path starting to get into gear in upper stretch, found his best stride late seven wide outside foes coming with a sharp burst at the furlong pole and got up in deep stretch for a minor placing. MISS D'S PRIDE tracked the pacesetter in the two path with a host of others outside in the beginning, dropped back unable to keep forward position inside at the seven sixteenths pole, could not keep make any progression around the turn but did show late interest on the fence in the stretch running dueling for a minor share in deep stretch. ARAMI'S SPEIGHSTER battled outside going six abreast in the beginning stages, kept a close eye three wide at the three furlong pole outside two other runners through the turn, bid for the lead bobbing heads four wide at the quarter marker, shifted to the five path still in the conversation for the front end turning for home but then yielded at the eighth pole between horses. TIERNAN tracked with runners on either side in the three path at the half, vied three wide between horses fighting up front around the turn, was in the mix having the four path at the top of the lane, could not keep up late and tired with furlong remaining. TENTOMIDNIGHT had the five path between rivals part of the early scrum up top, settled into midfield outside foes four wide at the half mile marker, ranged up four wide making a good run midway on the bend, was fanned out six wide coming to the leaders taking the corner, could not continued the sustained run and folded by the furlong pole.
