SMOKE MCLEOD had a narrow lead on the inside down the backside, maintained the slim advantage up front inside throughout the turn, spurted away from his pursuers at the furlong pole, just held on at the wire from the fast charging runner up outside, was eased up on the gallop out and left via equine ambulance. GO GO ALEXANDER had a stalking trip on the outside along the backside, started to mount a rally midway around the turn, swung out widest in the five path gathering speed at the top of the lane, found his best stride late and was closing in fast in deep stretch but just missed getting to the winner at the wire. SILENT MORT tracked the pacesetter with runners on either side in the two path, settled on the fence inside another keeping a close eye on the contesting duo around the bend, shifted out slightly two wide for the drive to the wire in the mix in upper stretch and finished up willingly on the fence to be a non-threating third. ELGIN PARK broke inwards on the break but was quickly corrected, pressed the pace between foes in the three path down the back straight, moved a touch closer dueling on the outside throughout the bend, posed the main threat three wide at the top of the stretch, could not find more in the late going and stalled between horses at the sixteenth pole settling for a minor share in the end. INSTANT RESPONSE was forwardly placed four deep in the beginning, travelled in the second pairing outside going three wide around the oval, had little response when roused for more run at the quarter pole and flattened out on the incorrect lead between rivals in the four path with a sixteenth still to run. ENCORE MO was void of early foot lagging behind down the backstretch, still trailed on the turn but was closing the gap by the guarter pole and showed a little interest down the late to pick up a weary runner on the inside in the late running. CELESTIAL HEART stalked ahead of only the slow starter in the early going, could not keep up to the group taking the short way around the turn at the five sixteenths pole and emptied out on the rail in the final furlong.

RARIFIED (IRE) was hustled out of the gate taking clear command by the five furlong marker, dictated terms in hand moving comfortably down the backside unopposed, rolled along through the turn having mild pressure applied briefly by an outside foe at the quarter pole, opened up quickly when the nudged for more at the top of the stretch and cruised home in the late going for the gate to wire score. RUTHLESS ACTION drafted behind the pacesetter along the backside, inched up taking the shortest path around the turn, skimmed the fence taking the corner, offered a good rail rally down the lane and finished up well enough, besting the rest capturing the place share well behind the dominant winner. GRETNA GREEN watched the leader three deep down the back straight, moved in on the outside around the oval to press the leader briefly with a quarter mile to run, angled to the four path unable to match strides with the winner straightening out for home but did ran on determinedly between horses in the final furlong holding for the show money. EPISODE tracked the pacesetter between runners early on, travelled in the second tier outside a rival on the bend starting to make a run three wide at the quarter pole, angled to the five path turning for home, could not threaten the winner who was in control in upper stretch, dueled for the place and show money outside two others in the final furlong but evened out slightly in deep stretch settling for the minors in the end. GO GEMMA co-trailed on the outside with a half mile to run, could not progress outside another still at the back end throughout the turn, shifted out to the five path for the drive to the wire having a chance for a small share in mid-stretch but needed more late to be a factor in deep stretch. KIMBERLINA shared the rear on the fence down the backside at the half, made no impact saving all the ground around the turn, shifted out just off the rail two wide at the top of the lane but could not offer a late finish.

SHE TAKES CASH was in a bit tight at the start and angled in soon after, settled off the pace near the inside, took closer order in behind but still biding time on the far turn, split foes coming to the top of the stretch, struck the lead in mid-stretch, won going away. ALFRED BELLOWS was away alertly taking control from the onset, shook loose from runners in midturn moving well within himself, still was well in control on the fence in upper stretch, found more when called upon at the furlong pole and prevailed for the frontrunning score at the finish line. GOOD TO BE LUCKY broke inwards on the break, sat behind the pacesetter in the early stages, edged up on the rail at the midpoint of the turn, took closer order to be in the mix two wide at the top of the lane and finished up with good energy, gradually gaining on the winner late but besting the rest for the runners up share at

the wire. SPIKEPHIL tracked the frontrunner on the outside, inched up to sit just off the flank by the half, was hard ridden chasing the leader making no gain around the bend, shifted to the three path in the conversation on the front end in upper stretch and ran on mildly between rivals holding for the show money. SUNSET SKIPPY was unhurried trailing down the back straight, put in a mild and brief spurt splitting runners in the two path with a quarter mile still remaining but could not get involved in the stretch running. COMMON CANTER was brushed on the outside on the start, stalked close to the back outside another in the early going, dropped back abruptly at the three-furlong pole seeing the field around the turn but did manage to pass a rival in the stretch drive. STRAWBERRY RESERVE settled between horses watching the front duo midway down the backside, retreated steadily three wide outside foes throughout the turn, stooped in upper stretch and cantered in.



TOTAL SENSATION had a nice set up on the outside tracking the embattled duo, moved in shifting off the engaged pair up top three wide at the quarter pole, pounced still under a hand ride in upper stretch, glided to the lead taking control by the furlong pole and was briefly tapped right-handed in deep stretch to hold safe for the win. BIG SCREEN BOSS had a good trip tucked in on the rail watching the front duo who was having a race to their own early on, edged up behind the contesting pair in the two path with a quarter mile from home, shifted out four wide in upper stretch with the eventual winner getting the jump at the furlong pole and finished up solidly to be second best at the finish line. AWESOME BEAT was allowed to settle into stride on the outside seeing the field early on, started to get into gear picking up an inside challenger at the three furlong pole, closed in smartly four wide at the quarter pole having a good chance in the five path at the top of the stretch, was no match for the front two runners at the furlong pole but did run on mildly passing the tiring early dueling leaders inside and finished up a clear third at the wire. SAMMYSAURUS REX broke sharp for the lead at the start, had a pesky speed foe inside through the backstretch throwing it down well ahead of the rest of the pack, battled outside under a rapid pace through the turn still going head to head, was collared by outside rivals while two wide turning for home offering no resistance and wilted between horses with a sixteenth still to run. DUCKDUCKDUCK was knocked off stride leaving the gate by the inside runner, settled in midfield between rivals in the four path early on, took closer order with a half mile remaining, ranged up three wide around the turn, started to reach for more ground when urged on five wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path full of run on the outside of horses at the top of the stretch, closed in steadily down the lane and drove by in the final seventy yards for the late running win. RELOAD RALEIGH had a head in front with runners on each side down the back straight, edged away from the inside speed foe at the five sixteenths pole, braced for the new challenger outside at the quarter marker, stubbornly dug in on the rail when collared outside in upper stretch, gamely repelled that rival by the sixteenth pole but could not find more in reserve one more time to fend off the oncoming charge by the winner outside in deep stretch. BIG TIME BOSS was isolated keeping a close eye on the lead three runners down the backside, was asked for more run to go after the frontrunner at the five sixteenths pole, quickly responded making a sharp move around foes four wide at the quarter pole, had aim on the battling duo at the top of the

lane but needed more in the late running when evening out between foes in the last sixteenth of a mile to capture the third place award. PRINCECREST was unhurried trailing the field going into the backstretch, started to pick up rivals passing the stablemate inside at the half, saved ground advancing on the rail midway around the bend, scraped paint lengthening stride coming with a rail run, had good late energy inside in deep stretch and got up right at the finish line to settle on the fringes. MISTER BLUE broke awkwardly to be last leaving the gate, improved along the backside under a snug hold to watch the leader outside four furlongs from the wire, sat all alone watching the embattled pair up top at the three furlong pole, closed in looming three wide on the outside at the quarter pole, may have poked his head in front for a stride or two battling for the lead outside in upper stretch, stayed on the incorrect lead to the finish, faded between horses at the sixteenth pole and was nabbed at the wire by an inside runner for the minor placing. STREETSHAVENONAME was bumped inside being pushed out on the break, stalked close to the back at the start, improved on the inside at the half, kept pace in mid-division under a ride through the turn, moved out to the four path for the stretch drive but lacked a rally through the lane between rivals. FLEET OF FOOT tracked five deep outside of runners in midfield in the early stages, regressed down the backstretch to trail outside at the half, could see the field on the turn travelling in the two path, shifted out three wide turning for home and passed a couple of tired runners in the final furlong. SILVER IS BEST bobbled breaking out at the start, travelled between horses in the middle of the pack early on, made little headway going three wide around the oval, angled out the five path straightening out for home but could not be a factor in the late running. BIG BOLD AND FIRST pressed the issue on the rail down the backside, continued to force the pace on the inside through

DILWAALA was brushed on the inside at the start, rolled along down the backside loose on the lead, continued to be unchallenged moving well in hand around the oval, cut the corner in control in the two path and under a well rated ride had more in the lane to win comfortably at the wire never being threaten throughout the race. HALCON NEGRO was brushed on the outside on the break, stalked near the rear on the rail down the backside, made little headway saving ground by midturn, shifted out to the five path full of run through the stretch and with a solid late charge closed in belatedly to capture the runners up share in the shadow of the wire. GINGER'S HOLIDAY was content to sit back off the lone speed down the back straight, was scrubbed on for more inside another foe chasing the pace setter but making little gain around the turn, determinedly continued to try to reel in the winner in the stretch never giving in but to no avail by the furlong pole and faded just a touch late when picked up on the outside in the shadow of the wire for the place share. WOODGLEN COURT tracked the frontrunner three deep outside a couple of rivals down the back straight, closed in three wide on the outside through the turn to loom boldly at the quarter pole, drifted out losing its run five wide in upper stretch and ran on evenly in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in the end. RUN MATTEO RUN travelled in the middle of the pack between horses down the backside, took closer order on the turn keeping pace with the lead foursome at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four having a shot for a small share at the top of the lane, shifted inwards at the sixteenth pole dueling for a minor placing but was outkicked in deep stretch. ASHUKA hopped on the break, stalked close to the back outside another foe early on, started to pick up the bit three wide going by a rival at the three eighths pole, closed the gap on the field with a quarter mile from home, swung out widest in the seven path for the drive to the finish line and ran on with mild interest outside horses passing runners down the lane. KICKING HORSE PASS was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field on the rail down the backside, started to make a move on the inside passing a rival at the five sixteenths pole, was reaching for more ground having a good inside rally in upper stretch, had to alter course off tiring rivals at the furlong pole shifting to the three path losing momentum and could not factor in the late running. CASTLE HARBOUR settled on the inside of runners in mid-division, was hard ridden making a brief run on the rail in the turn closing the gap at the quarter pole, had a chance for a piece of the prize three wide straightening out for home, could not sustain the rally and weakened at the furlong pole. EARNING MY EARS had the rail in the second flight at the half, could not quicken with the leaders midway around the turn, had little to give for the drive and folded while drifting in and out at the furlong marker inside runners. TEAM TALABAAT settled in midfield going four deep, was roused at the five sixteenths marker but was retreating on the turn when passed by rivals on either side at the quarter pole, shifted out to the six-path turning for home but failed to menace in the stretch drive. CHIEF LIONHART stalked on the outside close to the back of the pack, had little to give on the turn when relegated to the last place position at the five sixteenths pole, was well back in the two path upper stretch and cantered on in.
