BANKINGONAMIRACLE went head to head with the inside rival in the early going, edged clear up top by the half, had another rival outside pressing the pace at the five sixteenths marker, stubbornly battled on inside of the eventual winner in upper stretch, grudgingly gave way on the fence by the sixteenth pole, moved outside late and kept on coming to the wire never wavering, actually coming back on in the end but settling for second best on this day. SIGNATURE SIR was unhurried seeing the field after the start, improved on the outside at the half, made little headway travelling just off the rail around the turn, angled to the four path straightening out for home coming with a run and had a good late charge outside to get up for third money at the wire. EXECUTIVE SUCCESS assumed command from the onset, controlled the pace down the backside even though flanked outside at the half, was let out a notch opening back up again at the three eighths pole, had another challenger make a bid outside at the quarter marker, burst away once more under a well rationed ride in upper stretch and still had more in the final furlong to hold safe at the finish line. CONQUER THE STORM was allowed to settle into a rhythm rating kindly at the back of the pack, started to make a move on the rail picking up outside rivals at the seven sixteenths pole, was in full stride reaching for more ground shifting out four wide closing in smartly at the quarter pole, loomed a menacing presence outside in the five path at the top of the lane and powered past leaving the furlong pole to win going away impressively at the finish line. SUNNYVILLE settled near the rear on tge outside, improved outside of runners taking closer order by the half, was gaining steadily three wide midway on the far turn on the leaders, bid four wide between horses at the head of the stretch but was no match for the overpowering winner in deep stretch, easily besting challengers through for the second place share at the wire. PAT'S HOLIDAY had the fence in the second flight for the first half of this two turn race, inched up in the two path around the last turn, moved in two wide turning for home to poke his head in front for a brief moment coming to the furlong marker between foes, was unable to quicken with the top duo in the late running but did last outside at the wire for the show award. MY EMMY was under a hustling rider to have a clear lead on the fence, set quite a quick pace unchallenged down the backside, continued up top but by a shrinking margin while hugging the rail on the last turn, was collared outside by a few rivals in upper stretch, fought on inside until the furlong pole and faded in the late stages to settle on the fringes. TALLAWAH travelled three wide outside two others keeping a close eye on the frontrunner in the early stages, chased outside in the two path but to no avail through the final bend and wilted three wide between foes in upper stretch. SYMPATICO had a stalking trip on the fence close to the back, shifted off the rail at the half, retreated in the two path travelling around the far turn and had little to offer three wide in the stretch running. CHARITY FIRST tracked the pacesetter

laboured behind losing touch with the group midway around the final bend and cantered home down the lane.

KAVALA co-trailed with runners on either side in the backstretch while a half mile remaining, started to pick up the bit rallying three wide in midturn, had a sharp turn of foot circling around a couple of rivals four wide at the quarter marker, had aim on the leader in full flight at the top of the stretch, kept gaining with every stride down the lane and u der a well timed late burst got up for the win in the final jump in a tight photo outside. KATHERINE'S GEM had the lead on the rail inside three others in the early going, dueled on the fence having a narrow advantage inside running around the turn, finally disposed of the last of the early speed rivals spurting clear on the rail inside at the top of the stretch, kept trying to find more clinging onto the lead stubbornly with a sixteenth from home but just got nabbed at the wire in a hard fought loss. MI TORMENTA was part of the scrum up front in the three path between horses early on, dropped back to watch the engaged pair at the half, saved ground watching the battling duo on the turn, scraped paint coming with a mild run turning for home, was no match for the front twosome who had it to themselves late and finished up a distant but clear third at the wire. KID GIZMO was on

the fence part of the back trio at the half, made little improvement while going two to three wide inside another throughout the bend, angled out to the six path straightening for home and could only manage to pass a couple of weary runners outside in the final furlong. STOLEN was part of the early pace arguing between rivals in the two path at the five eighths marker, battled outside bobbing heads for the lead around the turn, had enough fighting up top two wide by upper stretch and tired between runners in the final eighth of a mile. HOT OMELET was part of the conversation four deep fighting outside for the front end in the beginning, could not maintain forward position by the half giving way up top, was scrubbed for more in the two path around the oval but was being passed by the winner outside by tge quarter pole and lacked a finishing kick three wide between horses in mid-stretch. LEGS LIKE FLATTER travelled in the three path sharing the rear with two inside rivals down the backside at the half, made little improvement on the turn while being pushed out by the inside rival three to four wide around turn, then still was floated out widest in the seven path for the drive and could not get into contention outside horses in the stretch run.
