PICKFORD SWEET moved smartly in hand getting to the rail alone up top on the rail setting a moderate pace into the headwind going into the first turn, continued to roll along loose on the front end down the backside unchallenged, comfortably kept on with little pressure applied by rivals around the last bend and had more two wide in mid-stretch when called upon to hold safely at the wire for the front running tally. MRS. HOT SHOT was under a snug hold on the rail watching the top two runners, began to edge up on the fence at the quarter pole, shifted out gathering speed two wide in upper stretch posing the only threat but could not get to the winner who had plenty left in the final furlong. THATSITTHATSALL settled in midfield four wide outside runners early on, improved position three deep along the back straight, closed in mildly three wide through the far turn, angled to the four path in the mix outside the leader straightening out for home, was no match for the top duo by the furlong pole but did finish up strong enough to be a clear third at the wire. ENGLISH JUBILEE had the three path between horses in mid-division, dropped back at the half to be part of the rear trio with rivals on either side, made little impact outside another on the last turn and could only manage to pass weary foes outside while in the five path in the stretch drive. KEY STROKE travelled on the fence near the rear, continued on the rail sharing the rear inside two others down the backstretch with a half mile remaining, took the short way around the far turn making little progress, scraped paint turning for home but could not factor in the drive to the wire. NO VISOR broke outwards on the start and was quickly corrected, could see the field finding his stride around the first of two turns, co-trailed down the backside three deep at the half, offered a mild spurt three wide at the five sixteenths pole advancing slightly, angled to the four path at the top of the lane but had little to offer in the late running. TATOOSONMYSOUL was antsy in the stall when the gates opened up to be off slowly on the break, recovered to track the leader three wide outside another on the initial bend, contently sat behind the pacesetter along the wind aided backside, was scrubbed on midway around the second bend unable to

close the gap on the winner, shifted to the three path for the drive, had little left for the stretch run and folded between horses by the six	teenth pole.

SERENADING KITTEN bumped with a rival at the start, quickly took command shifting in, set the pace inside, shook clear of challengers in upper stretch widening to the wire. VRANA (IRE) tracked inside the second group, came out a bit in the stretch, fought and won the battle for place. REMARKABLY HUMAN moved forward inside then switched out past the seven-eighths on the first turn, stalked outside advancing three to four wide on the far turn, loomed a minor threat at the top of the stretch, proved no match for the winner and was outfinished for second. TOTALLY IN CHARGE stalked the eventual winner from outside, began weakening on the far turn steadying slightly nearing the quarter pole. MAXINE MAGIC shifted in early moving up inside saving ground on the first turn, advanced on the far turn, came out turning into upper stretch, failed to rally. LOVE STRIKE broke outwardly, stalked outside a foe in the second flight, soon dropped back. BLAZE OF MISCHIEF steadily dropped back from between foes into the first turn, trailed well back, made no impact. RELOAD EH bumped with a rival at the start, was outside at the rear into the first turn, had no response. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF TOTALLY IN CHARGE AGAINST REMARKABLY HUMAN NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

SLUGGERNAUT travelled four wide outside rivals on the first turn in midfield, improved on the outside of horses four deep down the back straight, ranged up still going four wide around the second bend looming boldly, pounced outside at the top of the stretch and won going away easily in the final furlong. DROGON had a stalking role three wide outside of runners in the third tier on the initial bend, took closer order in the three path at the half mile marker, moved in on the far turn to seize control outside three wide at the quarter pole, could not fend off the winner outside while two wide at the top of the lane and

finished up well enough to best the rest comfortably for the runners up share at the wire. WAHEELA was nestled on the rail sitting in mid-pack, advanced on the fence at the half, ran every keeping pace just off the rail around the last turn, , moved out five wide straightening for home and closed in belatedly for the show money. CARRICK ON STAGE had the rail tracking the pacesetter, held position saving all the ground around the far turn, shifted three wide in the mix between rivals at the top of the lane and finished up evenly to be a fringe player in the end. ROYAL ENTRY was bumped on tge outside on the break, settled close to the back outside of foes in the early stages, offered a mild run three wide around rivals on the far turn, shifted out to the five path turning for home and showed some interest late passing horses outside. DEVIL'S TONGUE had lead in the two path with rivals on either side, continued on loose on the lead setting a lively pace down the back straight, was collared outside at the quarter pole offering little resistance and wilted two wide between runners in mid-stretch. GLORIOUS REVENGE took his head veering inwards on the start to trail in the beginning narrowed the margin still near the rear at the half, kept pace with others while travelling four wide around the last turn, had little fir the stretch run and weakened between horses at the furlong marker. ARRAKASTA IZAN was forwardly placed between runners watching the front duo, got the shuffle losing positioning at the half mile marker, inched closer taking the short way around the last turn to have a chance for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but lacked a rally down the lane. SERENADE POINT had the fence stalking close to the back, made little progression inside foes down the backside and around the far turn, shifted to the two path for the stretch drive but showed little in the late running. PUREHEARTS BANDIT was near the rear in the four path early on, lagged well behind the field down the backside, continued to be far behind on the last turn but did catch up and passed a straggler in the stretch drive. SUCCESSFUL CARRICK broke a step slow at the start, moved up to track three wide into the first bend, chased outside through the back straight, retreated between runners at the seven sixteenths pole, backed away abruptly around the last turn, stopped at the top of the lane four wide and cantered in.

SWAN LAKE tracked the pacesetter outside on the initial turn, was content to sit outside shadowing the leader down the back straightaway, chased throughout the last turn but could not make any headway on the winner, shifted out four wide turning for home, darted inside to the rail with a furlong remaining but could not get to the winner in deep stretch while holding for the place share at the wire. CORNWALL was close the the back being fanned out five wide on the first turn, improved four deep outside rivals at the half, creot up circling gradually three wide outside rivals on the final bend, had the six path for the stretch run and was gaining steadily late getting the show money while just missing for the runners up share at the finish line. SHERIF ALI had an inside stalking position close to the

back, made no movement inside horses down the backstretch, travelled three to four wide offering little around the far turn but did show late energy four wide between rivals in the final sixteenth of a mile trying to close in for a small share. THIS DUDE A BREEZE settled between runners in the four path in midfield on the first turn, improved outside foes in the three path down the backside keeping a close eye on the front two by the half, edged up three wide around rivals on the second bend to be in the hut five wide in upper stretch, could not continue the rally fading between challengers with a sixteenth left to run but did last at the wire in a photo for a minor award. PALACE VIEW (IRE) shared the rear outside another, had only one runner beaten along the backside, could not close the gap going three wide on the final turn, swung out widest in the six path at the head of the lane and found his best stride late dueling for a minor share in deep stretch. SOULMATE drafted behind the pacesetter for the first half of this two turn event, came under a ride on the fence around the final bend but was regressing slightly inside of rivals at the quarter pole, had nothing left in the tank folding on the rail at the furlong marker and was not persevered with late. GRAFFITI WRITER settled on the rail in mid-division into the first turn and through the back straightaway, was roused for more three wide between runners at the five sixteenths pole, offered no response around the final bend and could not get involved having the three path in the stretch drive. ELUSIVE KNIGHT tossed his head soon after the start seeing the field in the early going on the fence, trailed thru-out saving all the ground but could not factor inthe two path in the late stages.

ADAPTED was restless in the stall prior to the start, had an ideal set up on the fence isolated behind the contesting pair in the early stages, inched up behind the frontrunner at the half, sat posed hugging the rail waiting for the cue to go on the last turn, moved out looming a menacing oresence two wide by tge furlong poke and powered past with ease in the final sixteenth for the win. GOTME GOOD dueled on the rail setting a quick pace in the first quarter of a mile, shook clear disposing of the early speed right by the half, rolled along up top through the far turn, was clinging o to the lead on the fence midway down the stretch but was unable to fend off the winner late due to being softened up from his early efforts fighting for the lead and still dug in determinedly to last at the finish line for the runners up share. CAN'T JUMP was pushed in by the outside foe on the break, settled into stride four mid-pack outside on the first turn, was forced to move up in the three path between horses at the five eighths poke when the outside runner was making an early outside bid, tracked the leader on the far turn having the eventual winner to her inside, shifted out three wide in upper stretch and finished up willingly to be a clear third while almost getting up for the place share at the wire. # Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

PET SOUNDS was allowed the gather himself trailing in the early stages, started to make a move reaching for more ground splitting runners at the quarter pole, angled out four wide full of run in upper stretch, grinded away on the embattled duo in the final furlong on the outside and got up in the shadow of the wire for the late running win. BET N WIN was in hand on the fence having a good spot watching the contesting duo, waited for the cue to go drafting behind the lead pair midway around the final bend, moved in making a bid two wide in upper stretch, took the lead between foes at the sixteenth pole but was nabbed by the winner outside at the wire. AWE INSPIRED was nudged along assuming command in the two path early on, narrowly maintained a slim advantage on the fence while hounded outside down the backstretch, edged away getting the better of the early pace rival by the quarter pole, was headed outside at the top of the kane, stubbornly fought u til the end but gave way grudgingly in deep stretch being on the losing end inside of a three way win finish. THREE SONNY SIDEUP tracked the contesting pair outside in the second flight early on, settled all alone in midfield down the backside, kept pace on the far turn with the lead trio at the five sixteenths pole, shifted three wide for the drive and was gaining gradually through the stretch garnering a minor

share at the finish while just behind the dueling threesome at the wire. VOLCANIC travelled four wide outside of horses prompting the pace around the first turn, continued to all,y the pressure outside of the frontrunner along the ba side, was hard ridden through the far turn but gave way up top by the quarter pole, swung out to the six path turning for home, had little left to give and wilted by the furlong pole. SUGAR IT'S ELI had the inside position close to the back, was ahead of only one runner that being the eventual winner down the backside, could not pickup the bit inside of rivals two wide on the far turn and had no finish to give throughout the stretch. MODDASSAH stalked near the rear outside another, could not keep up to others while seeing the field three wide outside horses at the quarter pole and came up empty, never being a factor in the stretch finish.
