ROCK HARD ROSE broke outwards on the start but still had the lead getting to the rail when entering the backstretch, travelled smartly in hand opening up at the three-furlong pole, was loose up top well in control around the bend and had more when called upon to easily hold for the gate to wire score. DANCIN MARY MARIE travelled three deep watching the front two runners, mounted a rally four wide outside of horses at the five sixteenths pole creeping closer with a quarter mile from home, posed the only threat in the three path at the top of the lane but could not get to the winner in the final furlong and dug in in deep stretch to just last for the place share outside at the finish line. FAULTFINDER settled between horses in the middle of the pack, improved in the two path with rivals on each side three furlongs out, could not keep up to the lead duo at the quarter pole but did find more in the late running and charged up the fence in the final furlong to almost get the runners up share inside at the wire. MALIBU BETTY broke in at the start, shared the rear inside another in the early going, started to get into gear two wide leaving the three eighths pole inside a rival, continued to creep closer three wide around the turn, shifted to the four path turning for home and finished up one paced in the stretch settling for a minor role in the end. I LOVE PRESENTS had the rail position in midfield, tried to drive up the fence but was in tight at the seven sixteenths marker having to be steadied, lost momentum at the three furlong marker to be at the rear in midturn, hugged the rail at the top of the stretch and passed tired ones in the final furlong. FROGINAPOND co-trailed on the outside down the back straight, offered a brief run three wide circling foes at the three furlong pole, shifted out widest in the five for the drive unable to sustain the run in upper stretch and yielded outside by the furlong pole, retreated throughout the turn and emptied out two wide in upper stretch.

TANDHONEYWITHANE had an ideal trip isolated down the backside while watching the embattled trio, waited to move in on the fence around the turn, shifted outside coming with a run at the quarter pole, pounced three wide in upper stretch outside the leader, took control by the furlong pole and won going away impressively at the finish line. DANCETOTHERHYTHM stalked in the third flight on the fence, opted to take the inside route at the five sixteenths pole coming with a run, skimmed the fence at the top of the lane gathering more speed and had a good late charge inside to be second best to the winner who had a very favorable setup. LOVEUMISSUMEANIT dueled on the rail down the backstretch with two outside rivals, edged away from the early speed foes midway on the turn, rolled along but by a shrinking advantage around the bend, was clinging up top just off the fence at the top of the stretch, had no answer when engulfed on each side surrendering the front at the furlong pole but still showed a solid effort to finish up a clear third at the wire. POETIC AMY settled on the outside of another in the third tier, made a sharp move around foes four wide midpoint of the turn, continued to improve but was floated out widest in the six path straightening out for the drive and ran on evenly in the final furlong well back of the lead threesome when settling on the fringes. FIRECRACKER FIONA was away alertly for the lead initially, travelled three deep pressed by a couple on inside foes into the backstretch, relinquished the front end outside by the half, could not keep up to the leaders travelling three wide between horses in midturn, angled to the five path having little left, drifted inwards when tiring brushing a rival in upper stretch and galloped in through the final furlong. ROCKET RILEY argued between rivals down the back straight, gave way fighting up top in the two path with challengers on both sides at the five sixteenths pole and had little left for the stretch run when wilted in the four path at the top of the lan

BRAVO KATE had the lead in the beginning, took back quite content to let the new leader go on with it down the backside, started to methodically reel in the pacesetter at the three furlong pole, inched up with every stride measuring the pacesetter, pounced four wide in upper stretch taking control by the furlong marker and drew off in the late stages under a very patient winning ride. SARATOGA EMPRESS (GB) stalked near the rear outs, improved to mid-division with the field quite strung out down the back straight, picked up the bit saving all the ground on the last bend at the five sixteenths marker, closed the gap to have a chance for a piece of the prize two wide at the top of the stretch, burst between horses taking the place award with a sixteenth to go but could not threaten the winner at the finish line. PURRFECT GIRL was pushed in by the outside foe on the start, settled in midfield inside another rival in the early stages, narrowed the margin at the half, rallied on the fence then shifted out at the quarter pole on the final bend to be in the hunt five wide when turning the corner, could not get to the winner late, dueled between horses for the runners up share in deep stretch but captured the show money instead in a tight three way finish for the place share. HAY HAY PAULA was unhurried at the rear for the half of this two-turn race, started to lengthen stride at the quarter pole passing foes inside turning or home, angled out to the five path having good late energy at the furlong marker and closed in sharply in the late drive settling on the froinges outside when losing a three way finish for second money at the wire. MISTY EYED stumbled badly to her knees trailing the group after the break, recovered quickly to have the lead on the rail heading into the first turn, was on a mission loose up top quickening the tempo down the

backside, continued up top getting a slight breather on the last turn but had the eventual winner bearing down, still was maintaining a slim advantage in the two path in upper stretch, got leg weary a furlong still to run and was engulfed by rivals outside at the sixteenth pole. SILENT BALLERINA pressed the issue on the inside, dueled on the lead noses apart at the half, battled inside around the bend with the leader slowly creeping away, never wavered still coming on in a thrilling stretch duel and resurged in the final seventy yards to get her neck up front again at the finish line. ROSE FORTUNE had her head in front on the outside early on, went eye to eye fighting up top at the half, appeared to get the better of the inside foe on the turn inching away at the quarter pole, maintained a slim advantage outside in the drive to the wire but could not fend off the unyielding winner inside coming back on in deep stretch for the gutsy win. REGAL AFFAIR was bumped on the inside at the break, stalked close to the back along the back straight, could not keep up to others at the back of the pack having three furlongs still to go, rallied two wide by the quarter pole, shifted out widest in the six path at the top of the lane, was full of run storming home outside through the stretch but could not get to the front pair just missing with the fast closing burst at the finish line. NILE PASSAGE travelled three deep outside two foes in midfield, dropped back three wide early in the turn, was hard ridden starting to have a turn of foot a quarter mile from the prize, shifted to the five path straightening out for the drive and had late interest between horses to be a fringe player in the end. KASUMI'S GHOST had a hustling ride at the break but was relegated to the rear by the half mile marker, advanced smartly on the rail at the three-furlong pole, waited behind a weakening runner at the quarter pole, scraped paint mounting a rail rally down the lane and finished up with intent inside

runners fighting for a minor role. SPUN FOR FLATTER broke a step slow, recouped to be nestled inside a rival watching the engaged duo with a half mile to run, was scrubbed on at the three-furlong pole making no gain on the lead pair, could not threaten the front twosome who had it to themselves by mid-stretch and faded between horses in the final seventy yards losing a couple of positions late. GEORGIA RAIN veered out on the break, tracked the front pair outside another at the half, kept pace on the turn while under right handed asked at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path turning for home offering little run and yielded by the furlong marker. NO FRILLS had a slow start trailing the field leaving the gate, improved to mid-pack on the rail at the half, made little impression between in the third flight on the turn, looked for a seam three wide in upper stretch but failed to fire in the late running. FLY TRUE NORTH leapt up at the start to stalk near the rear three deep outside of runners, lagged behind being passed inside at the five sixteenths to see the field in midturn, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch but failed to be a menace.

FIRE AND WINE was coaxed forward while shifting in soon after the start, set the pace inside always in the clear, was encouraged a bit past the quarter pole as a rival drew nearer, responded by widening in upper- to mid-stretch, was kept to task and held safe. MILITARY TIME was forwardly-positioned heading into the first turn shifting in about three then two wide and nearer the fence at the six- and one-half, tracked in behind the leader and eventual winner saving ground on the far turn, was encouraged a bit past the three-eighths, swung out four wide for the drive, proved on match for the winner but secured the place. IMYOURMEDICINEMAN was bumped after the start, settled at the rear inside a foe, dropped back to last, switched out to advance outside foes on the far turn, came past the quarter pole four wide, kept on outside to get up for show. DIXIE LAW got away well, stalked the eventual winner two to three wide, was urged at the five-sixteenths, could not kick on and lost third. HELLO JELLO broke a step slow at the start, improved between runners along the backside to track the frontrunner outside at the half, start to reel in the leader while in hand midway on the turn, bid three wide outside in upper stretch and finally wore down the stubborn foe inside in the final sentry yards to edge away for the win. FIELD HOCKEY took command on the outside from the outfit, cleared off up top by the half, moved well still unchallenged around the oval, shifted just off the fence holding on the lead in upper stretch, fought inside down the lane but gave way grudgingly in the final seventy yards easily besting the rest for the runners up position as a consolation prize. YODDHA had the rail position tracking the early lead duo, settled in midfield by the half, closed the gap around the turn going two wide by the quarter pole, angled to the three path for the drive to the finish line and kept on late to be a distant third at the wire. KNOWING was away slowly stalking near the back end on the rail, could not keep up with others on the turn seeing the field with three furlongs remaining, began to pickup the bit splitting horses two wide at the quarter marker, moved to the fence from the two path in upper stretch by the

furlong marker and finishing up willingly getting up for a minor placing in the end. MONDAY MORNING travelled in mid-division three deep in the early going, shared the rear between rivals at the half mile marker, was checked briefly in tight at the three eighths pole losing its run and could not recover enough to factor in the late stages. PREETZAH'S STAR hopped up, trailing the group leaving the gate, mounted a three deep rally circling foes at the seven sixteenths pole, continued three wide advancing outside foes in midturn, angled to the four path turning for home, could not sustain the run and wilted by the eighth pole.
