TRIP ACES was under a snug hold rating kindly on the fence watching the embattled threesome down the backside, saved all the ground waiting for the moment to go on the turn keeping a close eye on the dueling trio, scraped paint daring up the inside at the head of the lane and inched away from the stubborn frontrunner on the outside in deep stretch for the win. PADRAIG controlled a measured pace on the inside up top, narrowly maintained the advantage nursed along on the rail throughout the turn, shifted to the two path holding his own at the top of the lane, dug in gamely while rivals on either side at the furlong marker and just missed for the win.. YOU AND ME BABY travelled three deep shadowing the top pair on the outside early on, took even closer order three wide circling in midturn when called for more, bid for the lead in the three path turning for home, was no match for the lead duo at the sixteenth pole but finished up willingly to be a clear third. CAT'S FURY vied between runners down the backstretch, came under a ride chasing the pacesetter in the two path throughout the turn, still was in the mix of things two wide straightening out for home but lacking a clear lane and ran on one paced in the final eighth to be a fringe player in the end. LAST AMERICAN EXIT was allowed to settle into stride having only the slow starter beaten in the early stages, ranged up three wide midway around the turn, angled to the five path full of run between horses reaching for more ground in mid-stretch and powered past in the final seventy yards for the victory. PRICELESS WILL broke a step slow to be at the rear while not in a rush down the backstretch, started to get into gear three wide at the quarter pole passing an inside rival, swung out widest in the six path for the drive and had a strong late charge on the outside to best the rest for the place share. UNCAPTURED MOMENT had the rail position sitting in midfield, dropped back slightly at the three eighths marker, narrowed the margin in the two path at the top of the lane and found his best footing late to get up right on the line nabbing the show award. INDIAN PEAK tracked the frontrunner when inside another along the back straight, edged up in the two path by midturn, moved in to bid for the lead three wide in upper stretch, seized command outside by the furlong marker but stalled a touch, fading in deep stretch losing some placings at the finish line. YOUR VALENTINO kept a close eye in the pacesetter travelling three deep early on, made little gain chasing outside three wide around the bend, still remained in the mix for a share in the four path turning for home but needed more late between runners when fading in the last eighth of a mile unable to be involved at the wire. KING ELVIS had a clear advantage down the backstretch, rolled along loose up top settling a brisk pace through the turn, was collared outside having the two path in upper stretch, offered little resistance in the lane and folded on the fence at the furlong marker.

MAD WORLD shared the rear outside another for the first half, made little progression finding his stride three wide on the far turn, swung out widest in the five path in upper stretch gathering speed and stormed on past in the final sixteenth of a mile to win drawing away with a strong late turn of foot. APELDOORN had a slim lead two wide on the initial turn, moved to the rail having a chasing role inside the new pacesetter down the back straight, regained the top spot at the three furling marker, shifted to the two path clinging onto the front narrowly in upper stretch, kept fighting to the end but had no answer when the outside winner swept past and still dug in late to best the rest for the runners up share at the wire. GELATO co-trailed on the inside, closed the gap on the pacesetter by the half, took the short way around the turn making little headway, angled out three wide behind the dueling leaders at the top of the stretch, moved out to the five path finally having a clear lane at the sixteenth pole and surged late to get the show money at the finish line. STRUCK GOLD was rank fighting the rider while forcing the issue on the fence around the first bend, assumed control in the two path down the backstretch, relinquished the front end to an outside rival at the three eighths marker, dueled determinedly three wide up top in upper stretch but had little left for the late stages and faded by the sixteenth pole. ERIE SHORES bobbled on the break, settled in midfield between runners for the most part of the race, was roused still keeping in range of the leaders at the five sixteenths pole, moved to the rail for the drive to the wire but lacked a finishing rally inside horses in the final furlong. VALLEY OF KINGS tracked the front duo three wide on the first to two turns, travelled three deep watching the engaged twosome outside down the backstretch, remained three wide when asked for more run on the far turn at the quarter pole, took closer order to be in the thick of things four wide turning for home but had no finish to offer in the final furlong.

CALL ME BOND had a close eye on the lead pair who seemed to have had a battle on their own, kept within striking distance doing three wide with an inside foe throughout the turn, grinded away on the embattled duo four wide through the lane and got up for the gritty win a few jumps before the wire between rivals. EUBANK had a slim lead dueling outside early on, battled outside with the pesky speed rival around the oval, kept his head in front staving off the tenacious inside foe while trying to continue to fend off the closing outside runners in the last sixteenth of a mile but just got nabbed at the wire in a thrilling blanket finish. BONGINO WARRIOR fought on the rail going head to head down the backside, argued on the fence through the turn, hugged the rail at the top of the lane, continued to be relentless in his pursuit inside down the entire stretch and ended up taking the show money fading slightly in a tight photo for the top four positions at the finish line. AUNTIE'S BAMBINO had the rail position in the middle of the pack, dropped back early in the turn to be stalking in the third flight on the fence, angled four wide in upper stretch and had a good late rally between foes in deep stretch settling for the minors all the while involved in the photo for the win placing. PROUDLY CANADIAN prompted the pace three deep in the beginning, watched the engaged duo inside the eventual winner around the bend, moved to the two path straightening out for home but could not get into contention throughout the lane. GUERRA was away slowly spotting the field many lengths down the back straight, moved up circling a couple of runners three wide at the three eighths marker, kept pace throughout the turn, angled to the five path turning for home never showing any quit and gradually was gaining on the lead quartet at the wire but could not really get involved due to his start. FOUND MONEY settled in mid-division between horses, backed away in the two path around the oval to be at the rear by the five sixteenths pole, moved to the fence for the stretch run but had little to give in the late stages.

PAYNES SPIRIT tugged at the rider pulling to the lead inside early into the backstretch, had a slim advantage on the fence in the turn, edged away from the

early speed foe by the quarter pole, spurted clear when nudged for more at the head of the lane and coasted home safely for the win in deep stretch. CARNEW had a tracking role in the fence in the secondary flight down the backside, took the short way on the bend keeping aim on the lead duo, moved outside off rivals from the rail to the two path coming on in mid-stretch, could not get to the winner late but did win the place duel inside right at the wire. RED WEAVER tracked the front twosome while three deep down the back straight, dropped back slightly at the half, got back into gear four wide mounting a rally with a quarter mile to go, posed a menacing threat in the five path at the top of the stretch, could not sustain the quick rally and stalled at the sixteenth pole losing on the outside of another at the finish line for the runners up placing. DARK DANGER settled on the inside near the rear, made little advance just off the rail running around the turn, gathered momentum shifting out five wide turning for home and found his best stride late getting up for a minor share in the end. MALDINI stalked on the outside close to the back end, made very little movement going three wide around the turn, swung out widest to the six path straightening out for the drive and finished up with intent in the late going while outside of horses. WILD CARD had rivals on both sides sitting in mid-pack, kept pace with the lead duo under a vigorous ride throughout the turn two wide, stayed on the wrong lead three wide in upper stretch and faded inside horses with an eighth of a mile still to run. GLASWEIGIAN had its head in front briefly into the backstretch, pressed the pace outside at the half mile marker, battled outside the front running winner on the turn only to give way up top two furlongs from home, had little left for the stretch run and wilted in the four path by the furlong pole. SCUDERIA had a poor start trailing the field leaving the gate, continued to be at the rear through the turn, shifted outside passing a straggler three wide at the quarter marker but could not factor any further in the stretch running. COOLCOLLECTED settled on the outside in mid-position, retreated through the turn in the two path to be relegated to the back at the quarter pole, lost touch with the pack in upper stretch and galloped in well behind when crossing the finish line.
