LIVININTHEFASTLANE had a good spot inside another tracking the lead twosome, edged up three wide holding position turning for home dueling with a inside for a seam, was no match for the overpowering winner by the furlong pole but did dig in late on the outside to nab the the place share outside right at the finish line. GLORIOUS REVENGE broke outwards on the start, recovered to argue the pace outside down the back straight, continued to slug it out outside the eventual winner around the bend, gave way fighting up top two wide at the top of the stretch and faded ever so little late but was caught right on the wire outside for the place share. YORKTON'S HONOUR bumped a rival at the start, tracked in behind near the inside, came out in upper stretch with aim and under urging, continued drifting out past the furlong marker, kept on late and got the nose down at the wire. CONNOR came in at the start, was quick to make the lead, set the pace inside, led them into upper stretch in the clear, was nailed at the wire. ITS IN THE CARDS stumbled into a rival at the start, settled off the pace racing mostly three to four wide, swung out eight deep turning for home, was forced to move out a bit by a drifting rival in late stretch, secured show honors. SLUGGERNAUT was sandwiched between foes at the start, settled off the pace outside, fanned nine wide leaving the far turn, was forced out in late stretch as rivals moved out. GROOT had the rail position keeping in range of the loose frontrunner while inside two others along the backstretch, was shuffled back on the rail at the three eighths pole, shifted out thinking an outside rally at the quarter pole, cleverly darted back inside coming with a run skimming the fence in upper stretch, shifted off the leader two wide at the furlong pole coming on and determinedly inched away outside in deep stretch for the win. MAGIC POWER assumed command from the onset, travelled comfortably loose up top down the backside, continued on uncontested well within himself dictating the pace throughout the turn, responded smartly when urged for more in the two path in upper stretch but could not find another gear on the fence in deep stretch just getting nabbed for the for victory in the final few jumps outside by the winner. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE settled between foes watching the frontrunner, chased the leader while inside another around the bend, remained in the thick of things three wide between horses in upper stretch, could not accelerate enough to keep up to the lead duo by the eighth pole but still finished up well enough to be a clear third at the wire. TIGER TOWN was jostled around between horses on the break, stalked near the rear down the backside, narrowed the margin on the turn coming with a good run three to four wide at the quarter pole, had a chance in the five path for a piece of the prize outside runners in upper stretch but could not sustain the rally when stalling at the furling pole. AWESOME CRUSADER had an inside tracking position down the backside, waited for the cue to move on the fence midway around the turn, shifted out three wide in upper stretch pouncing on the leader by the furlong pole and stormed on by with no resistance in the final sixteenth of a mile to win going away impressively with a late turn of foot. MAMBA ON THREE had a slim lead inside a runner in the early going, took the short way around the turn still holding onto a narrow advantage inside, spurted away on the fence from the early speed foe in upper stretch but had no answer inside when the winner powered past in the final sixteenth, still comfortably besting the rest for the place share at the finish line. RYE'S MY GUY was brushed on the inside at the break, sat

isolated in midfield down the backside, improved mildly outside of foes going three to four wide around the bend, swung out widest in the six path turning for home finding his best stride late and with a good charge in the final furlong was all alone at the wire being a distant third. HARPER CITY broke slow to be in last at the beginning, stalked near the rear at the half with runners on either side, made little impact going three wide around the oval, angled out slightly to be in the two path for the drive to the wire and showed late energy splitting rivals in the final seventy yards to settle on the fringes in the end. CADFAEL broke out on the start, settled on the rail in the middle of the pack along the back straight, dropped back losing positioning at the half, took the short way closing the margin on the leaders around the bend, hugged the rail straightening out for home, fought inside for a minor share by the furlong pole but faded in deep stretch. BANKER'S HOURS trailed the field while three deep in the early stages, made little to no movement three wide through the turn, shifted out to the five path at the top of the lane and ran on gradually in the stretch but could not get involved in the late running. NAMEOFTHEGAME broke inwards on the start, forced the pace outside the leader along the backside, continued on hounding the pacesetter outside throughout the bend, gave way up to pthree wide at the head of the lane and folded in the two path between runners in the final eighth of a mile. HIGHLAND SOCIETY tracked in the second flight while outside another down the backstretch, kept pace with the lead duo travelling in the two path around the bend, angled out four wide between foes unable to quicken with others making a move turning for home, had little to give for the stretch run and faltered in upper stretch.
