GENIUS OF LOVE was in tight at the start, moved up early on to track the leader on the rail down the back straight, sat poised on hold drafting behind the pacesetter throughout the turn on the inside of others, still remained on hold skimming the fence waiting for the seam to open up at the top of the lane, burst through having a clear lane taking over control at the furlong pole and held safe for the win at the wire under a patiently handled trip. KAVALA stalked near the rear three deep early on, ranged up outside of runners three wide moving well around the turn, bid four wide for the lead outside the front pair in upper stretch but had no answer with the winner slipping on by on the inside at the furlong pole, tried to come back on late actually inching up at the wire but had to settle for second best on this day. IRON PYRITE had the rail position tucked in close to the back of the pack, made little impression saving all the ground around the turn, hugged the rail straightening out for the drive and showed a solid late charge inside rivals to get up for the show money at the finish line. GIZMO'S B F F broke out on the start, rambled on loose up top along the backside, dictated terms on the rail slowing the tempo down slightly through the bend, was narrowly clinging onto the lead between rivals turning for home, could not go on at the furlong pole with others on each side and faded between foes late while drifting out considerably at the wire to settle for a minor placing in the end. LAUGHING OUT LOUD was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field down the backstretch, offered a brief rally circling horses four wide at the quarter pole, shifted out widest in the six path in upper stretch but failed to fire in the final eighth of a mile. MYSTIC SONG broke inwards on the start, was content to sit back outside tracking the leader in the early stages, chased outside throughout the turn making little gain, could not quicken between foes under a busy ride three wide at the top of the lane and had little to give

NAUGHTY DESTINY was sharply checked between rivals at the eleven sixteenths pole, recovered smartly down the backside to watch the lead trio by the half, waited for the cue to move nestled on the rail in the turn with a quarter mile still to run, angled out six wide gliding up to assume the lead outside foes at the top of the lane and drew off convincingly in deep stretch for the win. NOT SO SWIFT had a tracking position between challengers early on, sat poised outside of horses three wide at the three eighths marker, moved in edging away for the lead by the five sixteenths pole, dueled between rivals four wide at the top of the stretch, could not keep up to the winner outside in the final furlong but did fight on to last for the place share at the wire. ROSIEPOSIE was taken up briefly between horses shortly after the start to trail the field down the backside, began to pick up runners on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out three wide at the quarter marker gathering more speed, moved out to the five path finding her best stride in the drive and rallied to be a clear third by the time she crossed the finish line. ROOKIE COURT was isolated sitting in midfield down the backstretch at the half, took the short way around the oval keeping pace with rivals, had a chance on the rail for a piece of the prize at the head of the lane and finished up mildly in the two path in the final furlong to

garner a minor placing in the end. SILENT SUNSHINE emerged from the scramble in the beginning to be loose up top by the five furlong marker, surrendered the front end on the fence midway around the turn, stubbornly re-engaged inside two others battling up front three wide in upper stretch, had little left by the furlong marker and faded inside of rivals in the last sixteenth. LILLZ STAR veered out sharply on the break, co-trailed on the outside midway along the backside, regressed three wide on the bend to be at the rear with a quarter mile from home and could only manage to finish up down the lane passing tired runners in the final furlong. GET OUT THE VOTE was urged on the rail early on trying to be more forwardly placed, had to be checked on the fence losing momentum and positioning coming to the five eighths pole, made little headway just off the fence around the turn and failed to menace six wide in the drive to the wire. KITTY'SSPEEDYSTARR tracked the pacesetter three deep initially, dropped back by the half, travelled three to four wide retreating outside on runners through the turn, shifted to the six path turning for home but could not be a factor in the late running. EM CHAMAS was hustled soon after the gates opened up angling inwards down to the rail through the backside to chase the leader by the half, vied between horses under a vigorous ride at the three furlong pole, had enough going in the wrong direction by midturn and folded four wide shortening strides when straightening out for the drive.

GALLEY HEAD was forwardly placed watching the front two rivals while sitting on the outside, crept up two wide around the turn moving to the leader by the quarter pole, bid four wide between runners straightening out for home, poked his head in front by the eighth pole, switched leads late and found just a touch more to safely hold on for the win at the wire. VOICE FROM ABOVE was bumped between horses soon after the break, stalked near the rear in the early going, improved slightly outside by the half, was scrubbed on three wide midway around the turn starting to pick up the bit circling rivals, loomed five wide outside the engaged duo turning for home, kept fighting until the end, could not get to the winner who had something left late but did finish up to capture the place share in the final few jumps outside. LOGISTICS was away alertly getting the early advantage outside, shook clear from the group down the backside, continued up top but by a diminishing margin on the turn at the quarter pole, was headed outside by a couple of challengers travelling three wide in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly on the rail in the final furlong just getting nabbed late for the runners up share by the outside rival. HOLIDAY WITH AMY broke in at the start, lacked early foot to be at the rear leaving the chute, shared the back end with an outside rival having a half still to run, offered a mild rally three wide outside of horses at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane and finished up evenly to the wire settling on the fringes. TWISTING PISTONS settled in mid-division on the rail, came under a ride making little movement throughout the turn, shifted out to the two path for the drive to the finish line but lacked a rally between foes in the final furlong. VERY SAVVY had a stalking trip outside of runners, shared the rear with an inside foe by the half, lagged behind the group around the oval, moved out four wide for the stretch run and could only manage to pass a weary straggler outside in deep stretch. I HAVE AN IDEA broke a step slow on the start, recovered leaving the chute to press the issue inside early on, chased the loose frontrunner at the half, closed the gap on the leader around the turn but was being passed outside by a couple of rivals at the quarter pole, could not offer a finishing kick at the top of the stretch and folded inside of horses in the last eighth of a mile.

TEQUILASOUPERNOVA had an unopposed lead going down the backside, continued up top on the turn still controlling the pace while just off the fence, edged away even further when the rider nudged for more at the top of the stretch, did not switch leads to the wire but it did not make any difference and prevailed at the finish line comfortably for the gate to wire score. REVELER'S ROW broke out on the break, sat nestled on the rail sitting in mid-pack, inched up on the front pair in the two path between runners throughout the turn, fought on in the hunt two wide in the stretch drive, closed in steadily in deep stretch but could not get to the winner in time. I GOT MURPHED contently sat just off the leader on the outside down the back straight, was hard ridden chasing the winner but making little headway on the turn by the quarter pole, remained in the thick of it all three wide turning for home but evened out in the last sixteenth of a mile holding for the show money. LADY IONA settled on the outside of another foe in mid-division down the back straight, was under a snug hold circling around horses three wide on the bend at the quarter pole, posed a menacing threat in the four path straightening out for home but stalled at the furlong marker having to settle for being a fringe player in the end. HYMN TO HER shared the rear outside another at the half, made little progression just off the fence travelling around the oval, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane and managed to pass only an inside weary foe just at the wire. TABEI had the fence following the frontrunner down the backside, held her own still drafting behind the winner through the turn, scraped paint in with a shot at the top of the stretch, could not find more late and faltered inside in the final furlong. JUICY HANNA co-trailed on the inside with a half mile still to run, saved ground but could not get interested running around the turn and failed to menace in the two path in the late drive.

TOUR THE CITY had the lead on the fence in the beginning stages, relinquished the top spot to the outside foe travelling into the backstretch, waited patiently to uncork his run keeping a close eye on the embattled trio midway on the final turn, shifted out at the quarter pole reaching for more ground, pounced five wide switching leads at the furlong pole and drove past with an impressive late turn of foot to easily win going away at the wire. MAGNA TIME had an awkward beginning trailing on the fence behind the leader at the start, advanced on the first turn sitting in midfield on the rail, shifted to the two path watching the lead three down the backside, closed in three wide making a good rally around foes at the three furlong pole, seized command outside four wide in upper stretch but just could not fend off the overpowering charge by the winner outside in the final sixteenth. POSSIBLEMENTE was bumped on the outside on the break, recouped to prompt the pace between rivals going into the first of two turns, took the lead on the rail midway along the backside, continued up top narrowly on the fence through the far turn, was collared outside at the top of the stretch by a couple of runners, had little fight in the late going inside and yielded on the fence by the eighth pole. MOHAYMEN DIAMOND veered in sharply on the break but was quickly corrected, could see the field in the two path on the first turn, still remained at the rear along the backside, offered a mild run three wide outside foes making a brief move at the seven sixteenths pole, dropped back to last by the quarter marker and galloped through the lane unable to fa
