PRINCESS ANASTASIA missed the break spotting the field on the start, quickly assumed command controlling the moderate pace loose up front around the first turn, continued on unchallenged setting an even tempo along the backside, moved comfortably being nursed along on the front end through the final bend with rivals bearing down by the quarter pole, shifted out to be two wide turning for home and under a well rationed out ride had more when asked at the furlong marker to hold off foes on either side at the finish line. JUST MAGNIFICENT travelled on the rail in mid-pack for the first part of this two turn race, edged up taking the shortest way around on the final turn, skimmed the fence turning for home and closed in belatedly inside horses unable to get to the winner but besting the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. Z TRAIN (IRE) had her ears pricked up front going under the wire for the first time, tracked all alone behind the frontrunner on the initial bend and throughout the backstretch, chased on the far turn closing the gap outside the leader by the quarter marker, vied between foes three wide battling for the top spot in upper stretch but was outkicked in the final furlong and settled for the show award at the wire. DAZZLING CRUISER was unhurried under a tight rein trailing the field, continued in last well within range along the backside, mounted a rally circling rivals on the far turn at the guarter pole, loomed outside foes four wide straightening out for home but lacked a rally down the lane, failing to fire in the final eighth of a mile. RATINGS UPGRADE (IRE) stalked near the rear on the outside in the beginning, improved outside challengers down the back straight sitting in midfield by the half, could not quicken with others on the far turn when being passed on both sides at the quarter pole, shifted out five wide for the drive but could not play a role in the late running.

TWENTYTWO SOLES was off a step slow on the start, recovered smartly to sit outside of the leaders flank going well in hand down the backside, moved in, cruising outside taking control at the five sixteenths pole, shot away on the rail from his closest pursuers in upper stretch, proved much the best down the lane and coasted home for the win. SANHEDRIN had a stalking trip ahead of only one runner along the backside, started to uncork a run on the turn narrowing the margin by the quarter pole, shifted to the two path at the top of the lane, burst between foes taking the runners up share leaving the furlong marker and finished up a clear second best behind the dominant winner. CLEAR POSITION leapt up and outwards on the break, improved on the rail down the backstretch keeping a close eye of the front twosome with a half mile remaining, was roused on the rail at the three eighths marker having a brief turn of foot shifting out three wide at the quarter pole, was no match for the overpowering winner who had plenty left for the drive and finished up mildly to be a distant third at the wire. FULL STAR travelled outside horses in midfield, had a brief spurt three wide closing in at the seven sixteenths pole, dropped back slightly by midturn, swung out widest in the five path taking the corner and ran on evenly to be a fringe player in the end. TURBO CHARGED was bumped by the inside rival on the break, tracked the engaged duo with runners on either side at the half, chased the top pair while in the second flight outside another through the turn, shifted to the four path in upper stretch, lacked a finish inside runners in the final furlong and faded late losing the duel for the minor award. SUNRISE DRIVE got to the rail from the outer post setting a pedestrian pace around the first turn, continued to dictate a dawdling, even tempo loose up top down the backside, was headed outside briefly by a challengers at the five sixteenths pole, had plenty more left in the tank spurting away again while two wide at the top of the stretch and was kept to the task late coming home safely for the frontrunning tally. SWAN LAKE bobbled slightly on the break, stalked between foes in the secondary trio around the first bend, remained near the rear down the backside with the field tightly bunched at the half, edged up two wide outside a rival on the far turn with a quarter mile still to go, scraped paint straightening out for the drive, could not threaten the winner in the late stages but finished up well enough to clearly be second best at the wire. GREY PRINCESS had the rail position watching the front threesome in the beginning, tracked the front pair while tucked in on the fence along the backside, could not gain on the lead duo while scrubbed on for more on the turn at the quarter pole, skimmed the fence in upper stretch and ran on willingly to the wire just saving inside two others for the third place share at the finish line. FAST AND READY was at the back going three wide outside a couple of runners around the first turn, settled in last with the group very compact along the back straight, made little movement inside runners on the far bend trying to close into a soft pace, angled three wide at the top of the stretch and surged between rivals late, almost taking the show share but settling on a minor placing in the end instead. SAILOR'S PASSION vied between horses up top going into the first turn, was content to sit back, tracking the loose leader down the back straight, moved in to bid outside getting his nose in front for a fleeting moment midway through the far turn, shifted to the three path turning for home but could not quicken with the winner and faded in the deep stretch losing a couple of placings in a tight finish for the show money. C C'S KINGDOM was eager under restraint prompting the pace stacked three wide heading into the first turn, remained headstrong pulling at the rider three deep outside rivals down the backstretch, travelled three to four wide outside horses on the far turn but was retreating by the quarter pole and emptied out four wide at the head of the lane.



GOOD AS GONE casually opened up two wide isolated up top midway around the initial turn, continued to set a soft pace with little pressure applied from the outside foe down the backstretch, had a brief challenge outside at the half but quickly responded by edging away again by the three eighths pole, moved well in hand on the front end through the last turn and widened the advantage when nudged for more in mid-stretch to comfortably prevail for the front end score. BEDAZZLE ME had a good spot drafting behind the leader on the first turn and throughout the running down the backside, uncorked a rally splitting horses two wide at the five sixteenths pole posing the only threat with a quarter mile remaining, angled three wide turning for home but was quickly repelled by the frontrunning winner but still determinedly gave futile chase down the lane to be a solid second best at the finish line. STARSHIP SERENITY could see the field while travelling just off the fence in the early stages, started to commence a rally inside passing a rival midway around the bend, hugged the rail in upper stretch and had late interest closing in mildly to be a clear but non threatening third in the end. NIKITA'S GEM prompted the pace going into the first turn, shadowed the pacesetter outside applying only mild pressure early down the back straight, moved in briefly to force the issue at the half, travelled three wide unable to keep up to the winner midway around the last turn, shifted to the four path at the top of the lane and finished up one paced for a minor share with the field spread out in the end. PEACE POSEY settled close the back outside another early on, ranged up three deep outside foes down the backside to sit in mid-division by the half, regressed two wide running around the final bend to be in last by the quarter pole and could not find more to offer a finish in the stretch drive.

SPRUNG LOOSE was in just a bit tight at the start, settled into stride off the leading trio heading into the first turn, was forced outside a rival into that bend then shifted in, tracked up close in behind inside, came out in upper stretch, kept on in the lane to get up late. JOE WEST was coaxed forward outside and caught three wide entering the first turn, took the lead and moved clear shifting in to dictate terms inside, shook free into upper stretch, just failed to last. DARK DANGER was strongly urged from between foes at the start, was overtaken for the lead by the outside foe while moving in entering the first turn, switched out soon after, stalked two to three wide, was urged three furlongs out, failed to threaten the top pair late. CHANCEL cleared away loose on the engine just off the rail on the first of two turns, continued up front uncontested down the backside, rolled along still quite in command quickening the pace through the far turn and won easily, increasing the advantage when crossing the wire for the wire to wire score. STONKS was in no hurry at the rear in rhe beginning, improved briefly inside of runners around the first turn, was relegated back to the tail end sharing the rear with a outside foe at the half, moved from the two path in upper stretch full of run to be four wide at the furlong pole and while finding his best stride late got up for the place share but was well behind the dominant winner. GOOD SIN had the rail tracking the lead pair, settled inside another foe in the second

flight down the backside, kept pace saving all the ground in the final bend, angled to the three path for the drive to the wire and finished up mildly between horses in the final furlong just getting nabbed late for the runners up position. LOBBY BAR had the rail position sitting in the middle of the pack, dropped back slightly at the half, waited behind a trio of runners on the five at the five sixteenths pole, rallied inside horses on the rail in upper stretch and showed some late interest to be a fringe player in the end. GRANDE SOIREE kept a close eye on the frontrunner moving three wide on the first turn, contently sat behind the leader down the backside, was urged for more chasing in vain around the final turn, dueled between rivals two wide in mid-stretch with the winner long gone but needed more late, fading in the final seventy yards. SNOOKERED settled close to the back going four wide on the beginning bend, improved three deep outside of rivals down the back straightaway, made little impression three wide in midfield on the final turn, shifted to the five path between foes at the top of the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MEHLEK stalked between horses near the rear, co-trailed outside down the back straightaway at the half, tried to circle runners making a brief move four wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path turning for home but could not factor in the late going. ADAPTED sat alone watching the front three rivals in the beginning, travelled outside another in the second flight down the backside, came under a ride trying to hold position between runners midway on the final turn, had little left for the stretch run and faltered four wide between foes at the top of the lane.
