HOLIDAY COST was allowed to gather herself finding stride at the back of the pack with five eighths to go, started to figure things out on the rail reaching for more ground midway on the turn, had a sharp turn of foot skimming the fence passing a couple of outside foes straightening out for home, burst between runners shifting to the two path coming to the sixteenth pole and with aim on the leader late, rushed on by on the outside in the final seventy yards for the eye catching, late finishing last to first victory. MIDNITE SADIE emerged from the pack going into the backstretch being the clear leader while loose on the rail, rolled along well ahead of her closest pursuer setting an even but lively tempo around the bend, had a commanding advantage on the fence at the top of the stretch on the fence, began to shorten stride getting weary slowing down at the furlong marker and had very little left offering no resistance when the winner powered past outside easily in the final seventy yards for the win. LOVE PUDDLES had the rail position in the middle of the pack early on, edged up mildly on the fence in midturn, shifted out three wide in the mix for a small share at the top of the lane and ran on willingly outside of horses in the final furlong getting up for the show money in deep stretch. BETTERMUSTCOME was content sitting all alone watching the lone speed along the back straightaway, chased the frontrunner but to no avail through the turn, looked for a moment to be the only threat to the leader in mid-stretch, had little left late and flattened out inside of rivals in the final sixteenth of a mile to settle on the fringes in the end. FIRSTGENERAL NIKAO stalked near the rear with runners on either side, was urged on by the rider for more between foes at the five sixteenths pole, offered little response around the turn and in the two path for the stretch running could not find more to be involved in the later stages. STELLA POINT veered outwards sharply on the break trailing the field leaving the chute, improved outside of runners down the backstretch to sit in midfield three deep by the half, travelled outside a couple of rivals making little headway wide wide around the oval, angled out to the four path turning for home and came up empty in the stretch drive.

GOOD TO BE LUCKY had a narrow lead on the rail down the backstretch while inside of two others, patiently started to edge clear from the couple of early speed foes on the turn with a quarter mile to go, continued on the fence finding more when asked for run by the rider in mid-stretch and was kept busy in the late stages just fending off the late surge by the runner up at the wire. PADRAIG broke in, was then having to be taken up briefly when crowded leaving the gate, trailed the field down the back straight, started to uncork a rally three wide picking up horses at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch drive and had a strong late run charging home in the late going, almost getting to the winner at the finish line outside. BEE ME was tucked in on the fence watching the engaged trio early on, sat posed behind the contesting threesome on the turn ready to make a move, shifted out off the frontrunner in

the two path posing a threat by the furlong pole, could not reel in the winner who had something left in the tank and ran on willingly to the end lasting at the wire for the show money. SPEEDY CONNECTION vied between runners down the backside and throughout the turn, shifted three wide in the fray up top at the head of the lane, could not keep up to the winner who got clear by the furlong marker, dueled outside for the secondary award late but faded in deep stretch holding for a minor share in the end. GUS'S DRUMBEET had an outside position five deep in mid-division through the back straight, travelled outside of horses going three wide watching the battling trio up front on the turn, angled to the five path in with a small chance in upper stretch and ran on gradually to the finish line but could not get involved late. SOUPER VINNIE broke outwards initially then angled in leaving the gate to sit in the second flight between rivals in the two path down the back straight, remained behind the contesting trio on the turn between foes going two wide waiting to cue to go, shifted to the three path looking for a clear lane when taking the corner, moved inside a touch at the furlong marker finally getting a seam but stalled inside of runners in deep stretch. RELOADED FORM stalked close to the back just off the rail, made little progression taking the shortest way around the bend, scraped paint turning for home but failed to fire inside of runners in the last eighth of a mile. SPIKEPHIL argued for the lead on the outside three abreast down the backside, continued three wide dueling outside for the front end on the turn, moved to the four oath in upper stretch, lacked a rally in the lane and yielded to others on either side by the furlong marker. ALLBETSAREOFF was restless in the stall prior to the start, broke inwards on the break, sat three deep in the middle of the pack along the backside, was going the wrong way three wide dropping back through the field on the turn and in the three path had little to offer for the s

YOU AND ME BABY had a head in front I side another down the back straight, shook loose at the three furlong pole, rolled along unopposed on the oval, had company bearing down outside in upper stretch but was ready for the task and was u yielding I side in the final furlong to get the nose down at the right

time on the finish line e to prevail for the hard fought stretch win. LONG ACTING was bumped slightly by the outside runner who himself was pushed in on the break, recovered to draft behind the leader early on, shifted out in the two path measuring the frontrunner through the turn, moved in outside the winner at the top of the stretch, battled stubbornly outside inching up in the final sixteenth but lost the nod outside inching a very tight finish for the win. ABINO BAY had the inside position on others while settled close to the back, started to mount a rally passing outside rivals at the three-eighths pole, continued to close the gap on the turn, shifted out from the four oath in upper stretch to have clear run five wide with a furlong remaining and closed in belatedly to be a clear but distant third behind the top duo. WOODGLEN COURT settled in midfield with runners on both sides at the half, picked up the running outside a rival when roused in midturn, shifted to the four oath straightening for the drive and finished up mildly three wide in the final furlong to garner a minor award in the end. HALCON NEGRO had a stalking trip close to the rear while three deep along the backside, made no movement just off the fence in the running around the turn, hugged the rail at the top of the lane and showed late interest in deep stretch improving a position inside at the finish line. CARRICK ON STAGE had the rail sitting in midfield at the half mile pole, kept pace while saving all the ground around the turn, shifted two wide inside of horses at the top of the stretch, moved out further in the four path with a furlong still to run but flattened out late getting edged out for a placing by the inside rival at the wire. CASTLE HARBOUR sat outside off the leaders flank hound the early pace, tracked the frontrunner while outside another foe around the bend, gave way being part of the conversation up top by the quarter pole, had little left late and weakened in the two path in the final furlong. SWITCHIN' TO GLIDE broke inwards then was taken up, pinballed between runners causing a bumping chain reaction for some at the start, lost basically all chance laggingwell behind the field down the a knife and throughout the turn but did show a little bit down the lane catching a couple, rope of weary stragglers in the final eighth of a mile. SUCCESSFUL CARRICK was bumped on the inside by the troubled start, stalked close to the back in the beginning, advance outside horses but was getting out when sitting in midfield by the half, was nursed along four to five wide appearing to have issues navigating the turn slightly, swung out widest in the seven path turning for home and was empty in the stretch running. MIKEY BOY was bumped by the outside runner pushing him into the inside foe as well on the break, settled near the rear outside foes along the backside, offered a brief spurt splitting horses three wide at the three eighths pole, had nothing more to offer and folded in the two path in the final furlong.
