YOSHII broke a step slow on the start, recovered inching up along the backstretch to track on the fence by the half, shifted out on the turn coming with a run at the quarter pole, posed the main opposition three wide at the top of the lane, chipped away at the pacesetter through the stretch drive and got up in the final few strides outside for the determined win. MASTER STEAL was away alertly having the lead on the inside, cleared off by the half, rolled along moving well unopposed throughout the turn, still maintained control just off the rail in mid-stretch but could not fend off the tenacious winner outside late being nabbed in the final seventy yards. ELGIN PARK was under a snug hold near the rear in the two path early on, started to mount a rally inside horses following the eventual winner at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the three path straightening out for home and closed in belatedly for third money unable to threaten the front pair in deep stretch. PROUDLY CANADIAN advanced four deep outside of rivals to settle in mid-pack, offered a mild run trying to circle foes three wide at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the five path turning for home and ran on only one paced down the lane for a minor award. GO GO ALEXANDER prompted the pace outside in the beginning, tracked outside when the leader shook loose at the half, was scrubbed on for more chasing the frontrunner to no avail in midturn, retreated by the quarter pole and had little left to offer in the stretch drive. NOISY CRICKET had an awkward start bobbling on the break, lagged well behind the group gathering himself down the back straight, still could see the field making no gain around the oval and could not factor in the late running due mainly to the slow beginning.

SOUPER SUCCESS bobbled slightly on the break but recovered quickly to be loose on the front end leaving the chute, narrowly maintained the lead travelling comfortably in hand while hounded outside throughout the turn, shot clear hugging the rail disposing of the early speed foe in upper stretch and when asked for more found another gear late to safely hold on for the gate to wire score. INDIAN PEAK had an ideal trip all alone watching the contesting duo down the backside and along the bend, moved in two wide at the quarter marker posing the only threat at the head of the lane, kept trying to the wire but was no match for the winner by the furlong pole and finished comfortably besting the rest for the runners up placing. PRICELESS WILL had a stalking role near the rear on the fence, co-trailed inside another around the turn, uncorked a rally on the rail with a quarter mile to go and closed in belatedly three wide in the stretch running to be a clear third at the finish line. POSTURING had the rail position in the middle of the pack along the backside, closed the gap through the turn by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path in upper stretch and finished up evenly outside of horses to settle on the fringes in the end. BREAK THE SPELL was unhurried on the outside seeing the field in the early stages, shared the rear outside another foe making little gain around the bend, angled to the four path taking the corner but could only manage to pass a weary outside straggler in the final furlong. BACHELOR PAD moved to the outside prompting the issue in the beginning and along the backside, continued to duel outside for the lead but was under a ride trying to stay up to the frontrunner midway around the bend, gave way fighting up top five wide straightening out for home and folded by mid-stretch.

WINE AFTER WHISKEY was hustled on the rail to finally get the clear lead up top by the half mile marker, continued to control the pace while hounded outside throughout the turn, burst away while still in hand skimming the fence in upper stretch and was kept to the task in the late going to prevail by a quickly diminishing margin at the wire. PEPPER PATCH stalked close to the back end going three deep, trailed the group at the half, made a big swooping move around horses in midturn, swung out widest in the six-path full of run turning for home and was closing in with each stride in deep stretch but it wasn't enough to get to the winner at the wire. BRACHETTO hopped slightly on the break trailing early on, still remained at the rear by the three eighths pole, shifted out three wide at the quarter marker starting to reach for more ground, moved out six wide for the drive to the wire and found his best stride in the final furlong closing in to capture the show money on the outside right at the wire. EUBANK was bumped by an outside foe on the start, settled in mid-division between horses along the backside, made a sharp move gliding outside rivals at the five sixteenths pole to bid for the lead by the quarter marker, could not sustain the rally four wide in upper stretch and stalled with a sixteenth remaining inside of runners to garner a minor placing in the end. BEAUTIFUL THINGS had the rail position watching the front two runners, was roused on the fence midway through the turn narrowing the margin by the quarter pole, had a chance inside of horses for a piece of the prize at the top of the stretch but had little left late when fading at the furlong marker. FLYONBYE veered in sharply but was quickly corrected at the start, recovered to have the lead in the beginning, was roused chasing the frontrunner between horses into the turn, could not keep up going the wrong way when passed on either side by rivals at the quarter pole and wilted in the two path by upper stretch.

KINZIE GIRL stumbled then was crowded at the start, recovered smartly to actually be loose on the lead clearing to the rail heading into the first turn, remained uncontested along the backside, rolled along slowing the tempo down slightly still controlling the pace throughout the last turn and under a well rated ride had more when called upon in the final furlong to comfortably hold for the win. ORIENT BEACH broke a step slow, had the rail position sitting comfortably while rating kindly in midfield early on, improved on the fence by the half keeping a close eye on the pacesetter, crept up two wide while inside another measuring the leader midway around the bend, moved out in the four path with aim on the frontrunner at the top of the lane, wore down the leader surging past on the outside at the sixteenth pole and won going away smartly at the wire. CAIRO GIRL was hard held in the mix on the front end after the start, travelled three deep outside of horses in mid-division with five furlongs to go, advanced mildly outside going three wide around the oval, shifted to the five path for the stretch run, could not quicken with the eventual winner inside by the furlong pole but did show some late grit to get up for the runners up share at the finish line. TIZ READY exchanged brushes with the inside rival on the start, emerged from the early scramble to get loose being on the rail from the outer post by the five eighths pole, rolled along unopposed through the bend, still was quite in control in the two path in upper stretch, had no answer when the winner powered past at the sixteenth pole and needed more late when then nabbed for the place share outside at the wire. RIDEAU FALLS settled in mid-pack having runners on either side along the back straight, improved slightly saving ground the turn, shifted just outside two wide at the top of the stretch and finished up one paced to collect a minor award in the end. REALLY BIG SHOW was brushed by the outside foe on the start, pressed the pace for a moment between foes early on, dropped back unable to hold position by the seven sixteenths pole, was relegated to the rear three wide outside two others at the quarter pole, angled to the six-path turning for home but could not get involved. GOLDEN SUNSET was unhurried at the rear along the back straight, made a brief move on the turn splitting horses at the quarter pole, shifted out to the three path for the drive to t
