DA CANDY CANE set the pace in the three path, was coaxed along in the two path around the turn, tipped out to the four path turning into the stretch, and dug in, but was edged out by an inner foe in the closing stages. ALL AFLUTTER prompted the pace in the four path, bid in the three path passing the quarter, kept on to sustain that bid from the five path into the final furlong, briefly led passing the sixteenth, but hung late to show. WITSEC chased in the five path but made no impact. COZZOLANI raced off the pace in the four path, floated out to the six path turning into the lane, but was no menace. FLAT OUT FANCY tracked inside, tipped out passing the three-eighths pole, was roused into the stretch, tipped out to the four path to bid passing the eighth pole, and kicked on to draw past an inner foe in the final sixteenth. KARSON KAY moved up in the four path around the first turn to lead in the two path turning into the backstretch, lost the lead nearing the half, was roused from the rail midway around the far turn, retook command from the two path at the top of the stretch, and kept on, but was caught in the final sixteenth. MEDICINE SHOW stalked in the four path, bid between foes in the three path midway around the far turn, but was one paced along the inside down the lane. MAJESTIC IRONS bumped with an outer foe at the start, rated in the five path, loomed up midway around the far turn, took the lead passing the quarter, but bumped with an inner foe turning into the stretch, and weakened.
