STORMS LAST went to the early lead to midway through the first turn then vied for the lead on the inside down the backstretch, fell back slightly on the final turn before tipping out to two wide near the quarter pole to drive past the leader to prove best. ABSAROKA raced six wide in to the first turn then rushed up to take the lead near the six furlong marker, edged away on the final turn but was caught near the eighth pole and stayed on to be second best. CHEROKEE SUNRISE raced off the pace while saving ground down the backstretch then made a three wide bid on the final turn for a late run and was a clear third. ETHICAL JUDGEMENT was allowed to settle at the back of the field to the final turn then moved up from three wide to make a belated bid and improved his position. PASSTHECAT was allowed to settle near the back down the backstretch then made a rail bid on the final turn and tipped out to four wide in upper stretch to show late interest but was outfinished. MULTIPLE OPINIONS stalked the pace from three wide around the first turn then saved ground to the top of the stretch but lacked a bid and was not a factor. LEA ME BE was forwardly placed down the backstretch but lacked a bid before falling back on the final turn and passed tired ones. VICENTE'S SHADOW raced in the middle of the pack to the final turn before dropping back and was not a threat. R D C POSSE pressed the pace from two wide around the first turn then vied for the lead from three wide down the backstretch before giving way.

GOSPEL BLOSSOM chased the leaders through the turn, tipped out to five wide in upper stretch to show a late kick and was second best. SUNDAY NIGHT CODE trailed the field to the turn then made a rail bid to be a clear third. DIAMOND GAL raced near the back through the turn then tipped out to five wide in upper stretch to pass the tired ones. GREAT THINGSTOCOME shared the command from two wide to the seven furlong marker, kept on to the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner and tired. SLEEPY MUSIC shared the command from three wide to the seven furlong marker, kept on to the top before giving way.

EMPIRE RANCH raced off the pace while saving ground to near the half mile marker, tipped out to move up from four wide through the final turn and took the lead near the quarter pole and drew clear. DR J Y. G race six wide in to the first turn and raced wide throughout while being in striking distance, made a late run but was no match for the winner and proved second best. GOSPEL DON raced seven wide into the first turn then trailed the field into the backstretch, steadily advanced from the inside to the top of the stretch before shifting out to four wide at the eighth pole to make a belated bid to be a clear third. TWISTED STEEL went to the front to co-lead from the inside to midway through the final turn and was overtaken near the quarter pole but fought gamely to be best of the rest. MO MESA was fractious in the gate then broke well to co-lead from two wide to midway through the final turn before tiring. LIL SLAPPY was fractious in the gate prior to the start then stalked the pace from three or four wide to midway through the final turn but lacked a late response. OUT WITH TY co-led from three wide for a half and was done. EURO K raced five wide in to the first turn then blew the turn into the backstretch and trailed the rest of the way.
