MIA IS SHORT bid three deep in tandem with AUNT LOTTIE glued to her outside flank, chasing hard between runners while running on the wrong lead, kicked clear under the wire. AUNT LOTTIE chased four wide around the bend, roused on sustained the rally through the final sixteenth, finished willingly. COIN PURSE pressed the pace two deep around the turn, kicked clear into the lane, collared late by closers stayed on well for the show. SECRET VERSE very slow start, long sustained bid started leaving the quarter pole, widest leaving the furlong marker, improved position late. DENISES DOLLY chased the pace two deep, roused on into the lane, had no late punch. K O AMERICAN PIE chased off the pace and off the rail, bid between lane, came up empty. IMPUDENT slow start, roused three wide, had no kick late. SLUG BUG off pace and off rail upper, came up empty. IZZY'S G step slow start, rushed up inside into the turn, weakened. PAPAS PRINCESS quick start, set a pressured pace inside to quarter pole, gave way. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time available.
