INCLUDING ELLIE tracked in the six to four path around the first urn, ranged up to bid four deep turning for home, drew clear at the quarter pole and held from a late inner challenger. CAMS HOTROD tracked from the four to three path and between horses, chased along the inside into the far turn, yet rallied to bid inside of the leader in the final sixteenth but was denied. CAT TALE SKY laid well back along the inside, then rallied up the rail to gain show at the wire. MIZ RITHYM stalked along the inside, bid up a vacated rail passing the half mile pole, vied around the far turn, but got outkicked by an outer bidder approaching the quarter pole, gave way off of the rail through the lane and got nailed by an inner foe show for at the wire. SKY ECHO trailed two wide, swung out to the five to six pat into the lane and moved up. LEUCADIA raced forwardly in the five to four path before pressing the leader from the three path into the backstretch, sustained pressure three wide into the far turn, but faded between horses passing the five sixteenths pole. MISS LONG LEGS pursued from midpack in the two to three path, then in the four to five path around the far turn and failed to menace. SHE BADGER showed the way in the two path, then between rivals passing the half mile pole, got outkicked by an outer rival turning for home and weakened between horses. SHUTUP PLEASE pursued from midpack in the three path and was done early. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
