SECRET VERSE prominent leaving the start, rated off of the early pace and tracked three wide to the turn, was well placed nearing the quarter marker then bid four wide into upper stretch, rallied at the furlong marker, responded and took command into the final sixteenth then drew away in deep stretch. DENISES DOLLY forwardly placed in the early going while outside of runners, stalked the pace three wide to the turn, bid into upper stretch then battled ILIKEHER past the furlong marker, could not match strides with SECRET VERSE into the final sixteenth and won the nod for second on the wire. ILIKEHER vied for the early lead from between runners, disputed the pace to the turn then took a narrow lead along the bend, led into upper stretch then met the bid of DENISES DOLLY heading to the furlong pole, fought on to the final sixteenth, could not keep pace with the winner in deep stretch and just missed for second, while holding safely for third. LAMENTABLE JARIN allowed to settle away from the start, saved ground to the turn then was caught a bit in tight at the three-eighths, swung to the outside and chased four to five wide to the stretch, rallied at the furlong marker then could not sustain that run into the final sixteenth. KOOKY was hustled to vie for the early lead, engaged ILIKEHER and disputed the pace inside of that runner into the turn, lost a bit of position nearing the quarter pole, chased into upper stretch then faded in the final furlong. SLUG BUG was caught a bit in tight leaving the start and was shuffled in the early stages, settled outside of rivals while never far back, chased two to three wide to the quarter marker then did not factor in the stretch drive. IMPUDENT took back off of the contested early pace, saved ground into the turn then encountered traffic nearing the quarter marker, found room into upper stretch then could not muster the needed late response. O S U BUDKE chased the early pace from inside of runners, was well placed while saving ground into the turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch and came up empty in the final furlong. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time available.
