I GOT A GUY allowed to settle while saving ground early, roused three to four wide into the far turn, loomed at the quarter marker then took command into the stretch, drew off through the lane and was in hand in deep stretch to win easily. FRONT ROW SHOW contested the early pace from inside of GOSPEL NATIVE, dueled for pace duties with that runner up the backstretch then into the far turn, was overtaken by I GOT A GUY leaving the quarter marker, was no match for the winner into the stretch and stayed on to be best of the rest. GOSPEL NATIVE hustled to be prominent early, engaged FRONT ROW SHOW into the first turn then dueled outside of that runner into the backstretch, disputed the pace to the far turn, could not keep pace with the winner into the stretch and was a clear third in the end. GOSPEL FELLA tracked the early pace three to four wide into the first turn, maintained a three wide path up the backstretch while never far back, shifted to the rail into the far turn then lacked the needed response in the stretch. CHAHTA CITIZEN tracked the early pace two to three wide into the first turn, was a bit keen into the backstretch run, was outrun to the far turn then came up empty in the stretch. CAMS HOTROD settled while saving ground into the first turn, was well placed while tracking up the backstretch, given her cue into the far turn, took command into the lane then kept to task into the final furlong and held in the late stages. GOSPEL EXPRESSION broke alertly and assumed early command, set the pace off of the rail into the backstretch, confronted by CAMS HOTROD into the far turn, was overtaken by that rival into the lane but continued to fight on into the stretch, could not find the needed late response and was bested by the winner in deep stretch, while clear of the rest for the place. SLICK CITY GIRL settled between rivals in the early stages, chased four wide into the far turn, was outkicked by the top pair into the stretch but ran on late and held safely at the finish for the show. CAT TALE SKY allowed to settle, saved all of the ground up the backstretch and into the far turn, could not muster the needed response into the stretch drive and finished evenly. MISS LONG LEGS raced close up to the early pace and stalked three wide into the first turn, attended to the pace three deep up the backstretch, gave chase into the far turn, was outrun to the quarter marker, stayed on into the stretch but could not find a final response. BEAUTIFUL AND BOLD tracked the early pace from outside of rivals, was well placed while four wide up the backstretch, chased into the far turn, could not keep pace at the quarter marker then came up empty in the stretch drive. LEVIATHAN AXE tracked the early pace three wide, well placed into the backstretch, bid three then two wide nearing the quarter marker and took command into upper stretch, drew clear past mid-stretch, was all out into the final sixteenth then was nailed for the win, while just holding for the place. WRINKLE ROAD broke in the air and was off slowly, allowed to settle early on, advanced along the backstretch then roused five wide into the second turn, made a sustained rally to the furlong marker, surged outside of rivals into the final sixteenth and just missed for the win and place, while clear of the rest for the show. SEARCHIN SAFARI attended to the early pace from between runners, chased the pace to the second turn then vied for the lead nearing the quarter marker, battled into upper stretch, could not find more into the final sixteenth and weakened in the late stages. HE BLUE BAYOU broke alertly, showed good early speed and set the pace into the first turn, set a prompted pace up the backstretch, overtaken along the second turn, was eased through the lane and walked off under his own power. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

FLAT OUT FANCY vied for the early lead into the first turn, took back and tracked three deep along the backstretch run, bid three wide nearing the quarter marker, battled into upper stretch then took command into the final furlong, held foes at bay into the final sixteenth and drew clear in the late stages to prove best. IMAMIDNIGHTSPECIAL stalked the early pace while three wide into the first turn, kept close attendance to GOSPEL B. HAVIOR up the backstretch, vied for the lead two wide and between runners nearing the quarter marker, battled FLAT OUT FANCY into the stretch then fought on past the furlong marker, could not match strides with the winner in the final sixteenth and was clear in the end for second. GOSPEL B. HAVIOR sent to prominent early, vied for the lead between runners into the first turn then assumed command into the backstretch, set a prompted pace to the second turn, came under pressure at the quarter marker and met bids into upper stretch, could not keep pace with the top pair into the final furlong and was clear in the end for third. GOSPEL FREELY a bit slow away from the gate, settled while saving ground in the early stages, advanced along the backstretch run, saved all of the ground to the second turn then lacked a response when called upon into the lane. SEND THE BOSS forwardly placed early on, tracked the pace while saving ground into the first turn, well placed up the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the far turn then bid for the lead at the quarter marker, battled into upper stretch, found more into the final sixteenth and held safely late for the win. AMBIGUOUS tracked the early pace from outside of runners, was well placed while four wide heading to the half-mile pole, chased four wide into the far turn, was caught a bit in tight nearing the top of the lane and angled widest for the drive, made a sustained rally into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and got up in time for second. SHE'S A BOND TOO broke alertly and disputed the early pace, dueled between runners into the turn then took a narrow lead at the quarter marker, met the bid of WITCH WAY GRAY into upper stretch, battled that rival to the furlong marker then shook free past mid-stretch, drew clear into the final sixteenth then drew away in deep stretch to win as much the best. MISS BOWRING hopped at the start and was away slowly, rushed up in the early stages then was caught in tight and took up approaching the turn, saved ground nearing the quarter marker and ran in pursuit into the stretch, re-rallied into the final sixteenth, could not impact the winner into deep stretch but got up in time to earn the place honors. TWO RIVERS took back off of the contested early pace, chased two to three wide into upper stretch then angled further out at mid-stretch, finished well into the final sixteenth and just missed for second, while holding clearly in the end for third. WITCH WAY GRAY stalked the early pace from outside of runners, chased four then three wide into the turn, bid at the quarter marker then vied for the lead into upper stretch, battled to the furlong grounds, was repelled past mid-stretch and was outfinished late for the minor awards. MI MARNIE showed good early speed away from the start, disputed the pace from the inside heading to the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker then faded in the stretch. GOSPEL STUNNING chased the early pace from inside of runners, lost position along the turn then gave way in the stretch drive. FRIDA C broke slowly and trailed in the early stages, saved ground to the top of the lane and did not factor late. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
