SAND CREEK broke well but ceded the lead while holding the rail position through the first turn, was close up through the early stages and pulled into a tight spot approaching the half-mile marker, backed off losing a length or two then moved out a path or two for clear run, chased the leading pair to the stretch, under a stiff drive, was kept to task in the lane, gained the lead inside the sixteenth despite racing on the wrong lead and held on to the finish. YOU'REOBADBOY hustled from the break and chased close up inside, tipped out three wide for the stretch run, finished well under steady handling, had trouble changing leads but gained the advantage before mid-stretch, edged clear then held under steady handling to the wire. RIGHT CIDER raced in the middle of the pack while staying on the rail, was patiently handled through the turn then responded when set down approaching the top of the stretch, finished up well inside, was gaining on the winner but ran out of time. ISAIDWHATISAID lacked early speed and was at the back of the field down the backstretch, started a sustaned run after passing the half-mile pole, took the inside path through the turn then angled five wide into the stretch, finished with good energy but was too late. TOUGH TROOPER broke well then dueled outside of TEXHOMA through the early stages, got the better of that one leaving the quarter pole then led the field into the stretch, dug in when challenged but weakened and gave up the lead late. TIGERSAURUS REX broke well and was up with the early leaders but under a ride to keep pace, came under left handed urging passing the quarter pole and finished evenly in the stretch. SHARP AS DAMASCUS lacked early speed and was near the back of the pack in the early stages, made a mild middle move, loomed close up at the top of the stretch, finished with some interest but lacked a winning kick. WORK ZONE was outrun early and last into the turn, went four wide into the stretch and passed a few after the issue had long been decided up front. ZIM'S TRANS AM raced mid-pack two to three wide and finished evenly while never a threat. TEXOMA broke well, dueled with TOUGH TROOPER through the turn then gave way past the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. DAKOTA MARVIN was close up in the initial stages then dropped back to mid-pack, was taken up near the three furlong marker, lost momentum then taken six or seven wide on the last turn and not persevered with to the finish. VISUAL POWERHOUSE raced close up seven wide down the backstretch, went clear of the pack three deep with GOSPEL DON and OUT WITH MATHEW, assumed commmand before the quarter pole, drew clear and widened in the stretch, geared down near the finish. TOO COLD AT HOME was not involved in the early pace and raced in the middle of the second flight down the backstretch, angled out to the three path midway on the turn then came three wide into the stretch finished well but could only chase the winner home while well clear of the rest. FULLY FUNDED five deep in the early pace battle, was the first to go after the trio that broke away from the pack on the turn, came under urging from the quarter pole and outfinished all but two to win the third prize. MAGICAL MAX vied six wide down the backstretch, backed off the pace into a tracking position then tried to re-bid six wide into the stretch and produced a steady if slow finish to improve late. GOSPEL DON showed good speed from the break, vied four deep in the early pace mix then pulled ahead

with OUT WITH MATHEW going into the turn, loomed a threat from the quarter pole then flattened out before mid-stretch. ARCH OF SWORDS dropped far back early, saved ground through the turn and ran on some to improve position. DI RISATA MOLTO stumbled badly at the start then raced mid-pack three wide, started a mild bid still three wide on the tun but flattened out in the stretch. OUT WITH MATHEW was two deep in the early pace scramble them poked a head in front, vied inside a pair of rivals through the turn, gave way passing the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. APPEALS LAST RIDE broke well, was in between as several contested the early lead, could not keep pace on the turn and was not a factor in the stretch. EL SARGENTO C got shuffled back at the start when DI RISATA MOLTO came over recovering from the stumble, then raced between horses in the second flight through the early running then faltered mid-way on the turn and did not factor late. WARM SMILE was close up on the rail in the initial stages then retreated through the turn and had nothing to offer in the stretch. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
