LAPIS LAZULI vied for the early lead from between runners then assumed command into the turn, set a pressured pace to the quarter pole then shook free into upper stretch, drew off through the lane and coasted under a hand ride in the final sixteenth. AWESOME OUTLAW tracked the early pace while widest up the backstretch, chased four to five wide into the turn, ran in pursuit of LAPIS LAZULI into upper stretch, was no match for the winner into the final sixteenth and stayed on late to earn the place honors. MAJOR GRIFFIN pressed the early pace from the inside, lost position into the turn and chased from the rail nearing the quarter marker, angled out in upper stretch, could not keep pace with the winner in the lane, kept on into deep stretch and just missed for second, while just holding for third. HARD CANDY rated off of the contested early pace, raced in traffic nearing the quarter pole then angled five wide into upper stretch, finished evenly in the lane and missed for the minor awards. STARBURST broke a bit awkwardly, recovered then tracked the early pace from the inside, saved ground into the turn then was outrun to the quarter marker, chased from the rail into the stretch and passed tired rivals in the late stages. KICK IT AGAIN BOB off a bit slowly leaving the start, recovered and tracked from the second flight heading to the turn, chased three to four wide at the quarter pole, ran in pursuit into the stretch and weakened in the drive. MIRANDEN close up in the early stages, stalked the pace four wide to the turn, went up and pressed the pace two wide nearing the quarter marker, outkicked into upper stretch, lacked a response into the final furlong and faded late. WIN FOR FUN hopped at the start and was a bit slow to begin, lacked early speed, trailed into the turn then did not factor in the stretch and tired in the drive.
